Docking: Tender — ships anchor in the bay; boats land at the village quay

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Jardin Botanique de Deshaies** — A 17-acre tropical garden with waterfalls, exotic birds (flamingos, parrots), and sweeping views over the bay.
- **Grande Anse Beach** — One of Guadeloupe's most beautiful beaches — broad golden sand, clear turquoise water, and palm-tree shade, about 2.5...
- **Death in Paradise Filming Locations** — Deshaies is the real-life 'Honoré' from the long-running BBC mystery series.
- **Snorkeling at the Cousteau Reserve** — The Jacques Cousteau Underwater Reserve near Malendure (30 min south) offers some of the Caribbean's best protected...
- **Creole Village Lunch** — Deshaies's waterfront restaurants serve authentic Guadeloupean Creole cooking — accras de morue (salt-cod fritters)...

BEST WALKS

- **Village to Grande Anse Beach** 2.5 km · 25–30 min · Easy–Moderate — From the village quay, head north along the main road through the village, past the colourful Creole houses, and continue up to Grande...
- **Village waterfront stroll** 0.5 km · 15 min · Easy — Wander the village seafront — the fishing port, the market, and the colourful wooden houses that doubled as the fictional 'Honoré.'...

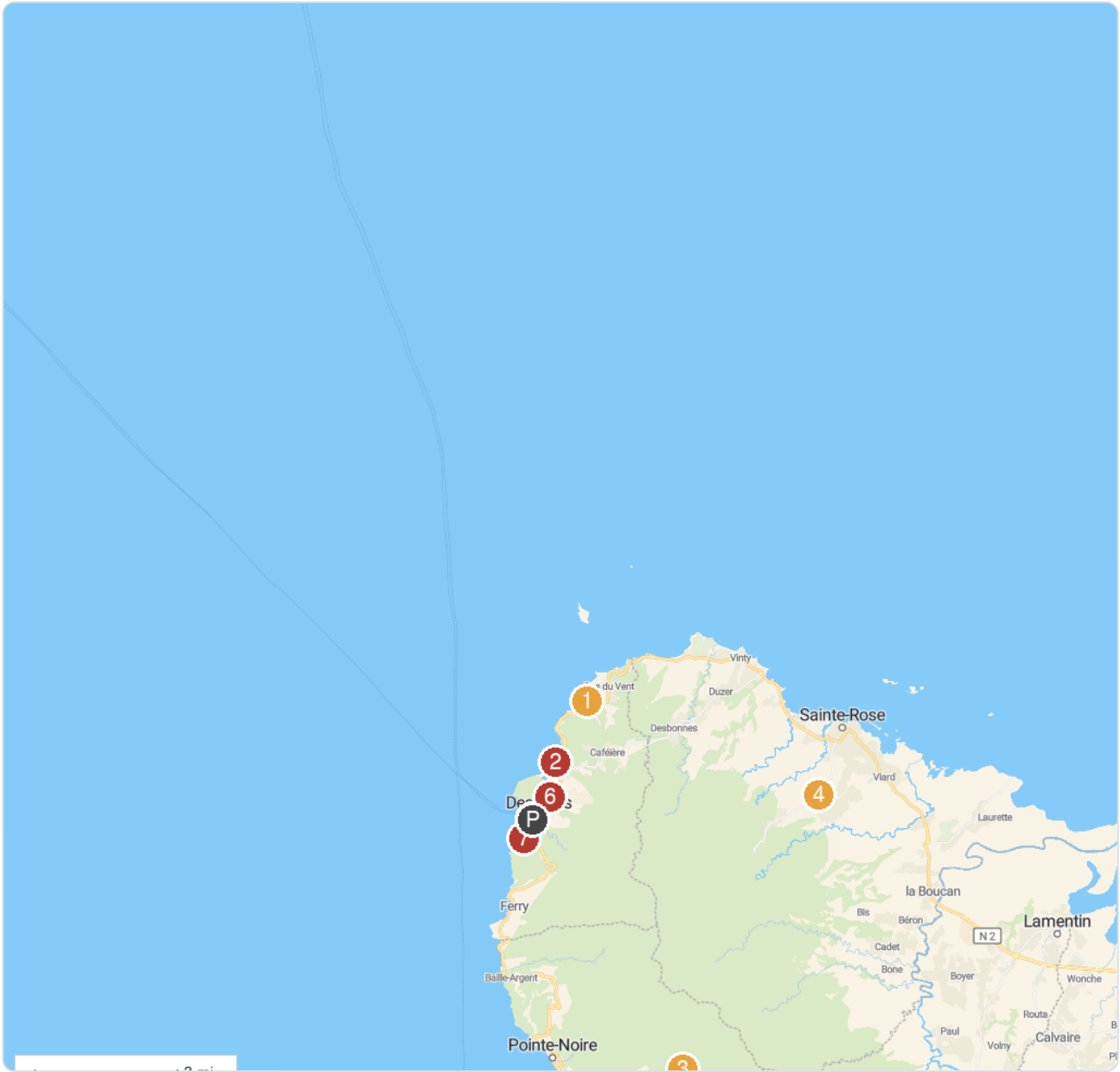
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
