TOP THINGS TO DO

- The Henry Ford Museum & Greenfield Village** — Rosa Parks' bus, Lincoln's chair from Ford's Theatre, Edison's actual Menlo Park lab — this massive complex in Dearborn...
 - Motown Museum — Hitsville U.S.A.** — Stand in Studio A where Stevie Wonder, The Supremes, Marvin Gaye, and the Jackson 5 cut their hits.
- Art Deco Downtown Walk** — Detroit has some of the finest Art Deco architecture in North America.
 - Detroit Institute of Arts (DIA)** — One of the top art museums in the US.
 - Coney Dog Rivalry & Detroit Pizza** — Detroit has two iconic foods: the Coney Dog (beanless chili, mustard, onions) from Lafayette or American Coney Island...

BEST WALKS

- Riverwalk & Hart Plaza** 1.5 miles · easy · 30–45 min one way — Head west from the cruise terminal along the Detroit Riverwalk past Hart Plaza — site of the iconic Horace Dodge Fountain and sweeping...
- Financial District Art Deco Loop** 1.5 miles · easy · 1–1.5 hrs — Walk north from the Renaissance Center to the Guardian Building — enter the free lobby and spend 15 minutes marveling at the Art Deco...

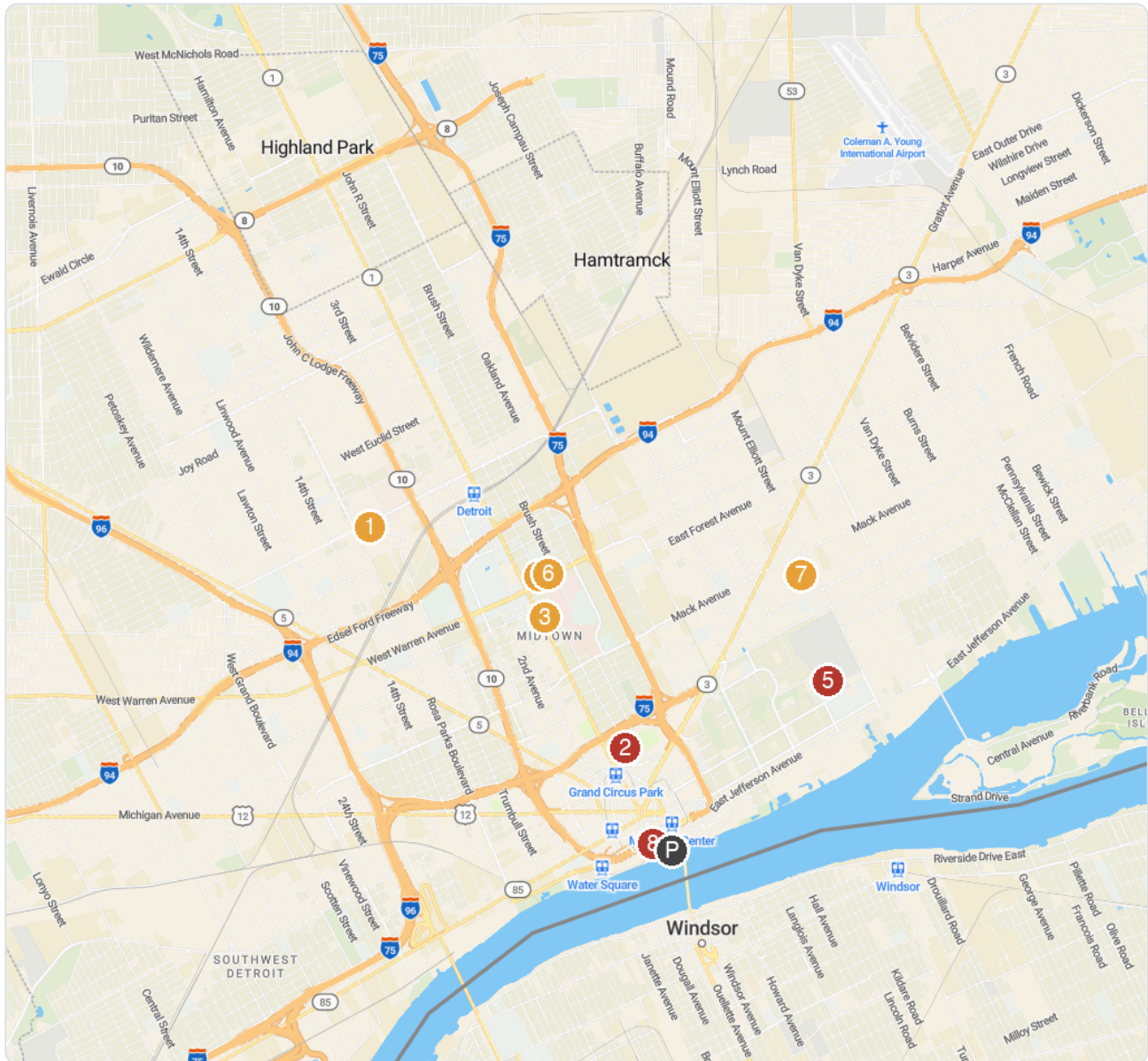
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Book Motown Museum in advance. Tours are timed, small-group, and sell out days ahead — especially during cruise season. Buy tickets at motownmuseum.org before your ship arrives.
- Great Lakes weather swings fast. Summer can hit 90°F and humid, or turn cool with lake wind. Pack a light layer even in July; the Riverwalk breeze can surprise you.
