TOP THINGS TO DO

- Cradle Mountain Day Trip** — The crown jewel of Tasmanian wilderness — jagged dolerite peaks reflected in Dove Lake, roaming wombats, and ancient...
- Don River Railway** — Volunteer-run heritage railway that steams through bushland along the Don River to Coles Beach.
- Platypus Spotting — Tasmanian Arboretum** — The 120-hectare Tasmanian Arboretum in Eugenana (15 min drive) is one of the world's most reliable spots to see wild...
- Bass Strait Maritime Centre** — Explore the treacherous history of the Bass Strait crossing through interactive exhibits — including a ship simulator...
- House of Anvers Chocolate & Latrobe** — Drive 10 minutes to Latrobe for House of Anvers, a Belgian-style chocolate factory with free tastings and a chocolate...

BEST WALKS

- Mersey Bluff & Lighthouse Headland** 3 km one-way | Easy | 45 min — Walk west from the CBD along the river foreshore, past the Bass Strait Maritime Centre, and out to the dramatic red-striped Mersey...
- Coles Beach Coastal Pathway** 3.5 km one-way | Easy | 50 min — Continue past the lighthouse along the flat coastal track to Coles Beach — a long stretch of Bass Strait sand popular with surfers.

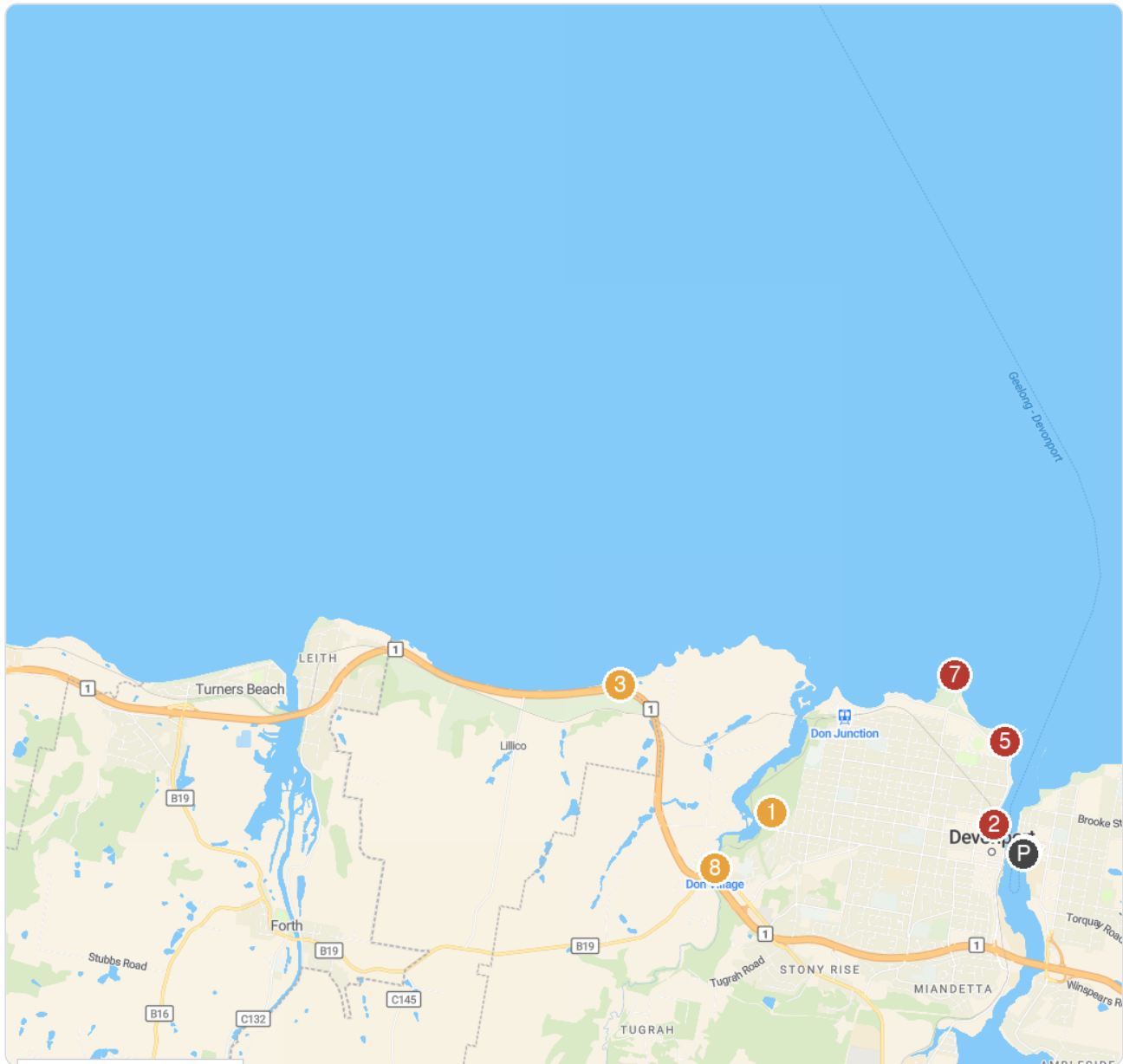
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
