- **Château-Musée de Dieppe** — A 14th-century cliff-top castle housing one of Europe's finest collections of carved ivory — Dieppe was once the world...
- **Dieppe Raid Memorial Museum** — Housed in a 19th-century theater, this moving museum commemorates the August 1942 Jubilee Raid where over 900 Canadian...
- **Saturday Grand Market** — Voted the Finest Market in France in 2020, Dieppe's Saturday market spreads across the town center with Norman cheeses...
- **Alabaster Coast Cliff Walk** — Dieppe sits on the famous Côte d'Albâtre — the same dramatic chalk cliffs Monet painted at Étretat.
- **Normandy Seafood Lunch on Quai Henri IV** — Dieppe is the scallop capital of France — the Quai Henri IV waterfront promenade is lined with seafood brasseries...

BEST WALKS

- **Town Center & Waterfront Loop** 2-3 km · 45-60 min · Easy · Free — From the pier, walk along the Quai Henri IV marina to the Grande Rue pedestrian shopping street, visit the magnificent Église...
- **Cliffside Chapel Panorama** 3-4 km · 60-75 min · Moderate (steep stairs) · Free — Head east along the seafront promenade past the pebble beach to the base of the eastern cliff, then climb the steps to the...

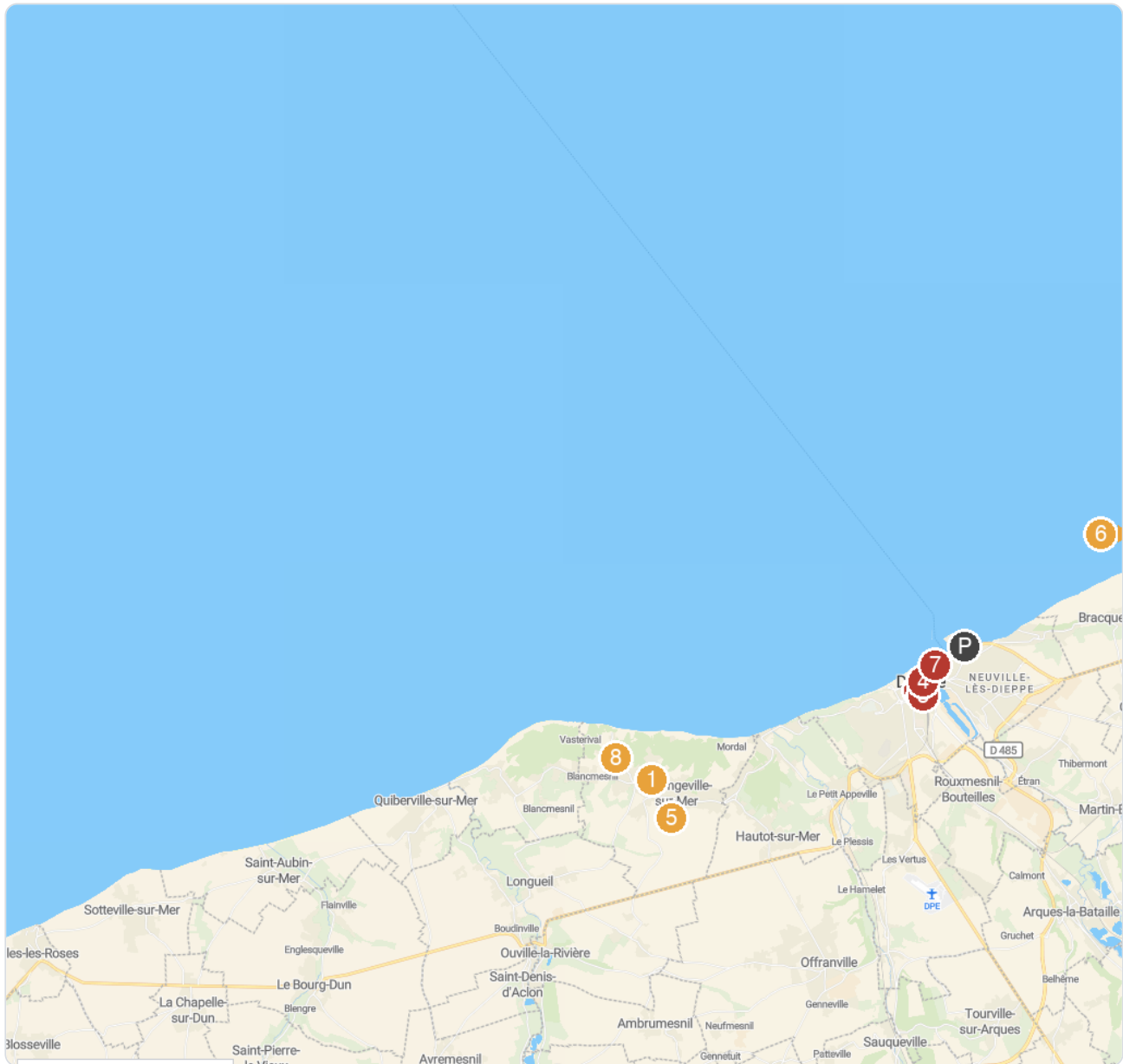
