GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier for small-medium ships; larger vessels anchor and tender to the harbor

Walk to center: 5 min flat stroll along the promenade (Kordon)

Best For: Ancient ruins (Pergamon), beach days, authentic Turkish town life

Don't Miss: Pergamon Acropolis cable car & the Tuesday weekly market

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Pergamon Acropolis & Asclepion** — One of antiquity's great cities — the Acropolis clings to a dramatic hilltop with the world's steepest ancient theater...
- Killik Bay & Thermal Mud Baths** — Drive south to Bademli's Killik Bay — often called the 'Maldives of the Aegean' for its turquoise water and distinctive...
- Çandarlı Castle** — A beautifully preserved Genoese fortress perched over the sea in the coastal town of Çandarlı.
- Dikili Tuesday Market** — If your ship calls on Tuesday, walk straight to the weekly pazar.
- Dikili Blue Flag Beach** — A long sandy public beach just north of the pier, awarded Blue Flag status for its clean water.

BEST WALKS

- Kordon Promenade Stroll** 1.5 km · Flat · 20 min — Walk the seafront Kordon from the pier north past fish restaurants, tea gardens, and the public beach.
- Town Center & Mosque** 2 km · Flat · 30 min — Head inland from the promenade to Dikili's central square and the Merkez Camii mosque.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Negotiate taxis before you get in. Agree on a round-trip flat rate (in EUR/USD) including driver wait time for Pergamon — around €40–55 per taxi for a shared group is typical.
- ATMs are 5 min from the pier. Turkish Lira gets you better prices at markets and local cafes. Many restaurants accept euros or
