TOP THINGS TO DO

- Slea Head Drive** — The classic loop around the tip of the Dingle Peninsula takes in towering sea cliffs, Blasket Islands views, Iron Age...
- Gallarus Oratory & Dunbeg Fort** — Visit the perfectly preserved 8th-century dry-stone oratory at Gallarus — one of the best-preserved early Christian...
- Blasket Islands Boat Trip** — Take a boat out to the Great Blasket Island — an uninhabited island with a remarkable literary heritage and abundant...
- Dingle Distillery Tour** — The award-winning Dingle Distillery crafts single malt whiskey, gin, and vodka in small batches.
- Inch Beach** — A three-mile Blue Flag beach with dramatic Atlantic surf, Inch Beach is one of Ireland's most photogenic strands...

BEST WALKS

- Dingle Harbour & Town Stroll** 45 min · Easy · Flat — A leisurely loop from the marina pier along the harbor front, past the Fungie dolphin statue, up through the main street (An Daingean)...
- Up to the Conor Pass Viewpoint (by taxi/tour)** 1.5 hrs · Taxi/tour needed · Dramatic views — Take a taxi up to Conor Pass, the highest mountain pass in Ireland, for sweeping views over the peninsula, lakes below, and Brandon Bay.

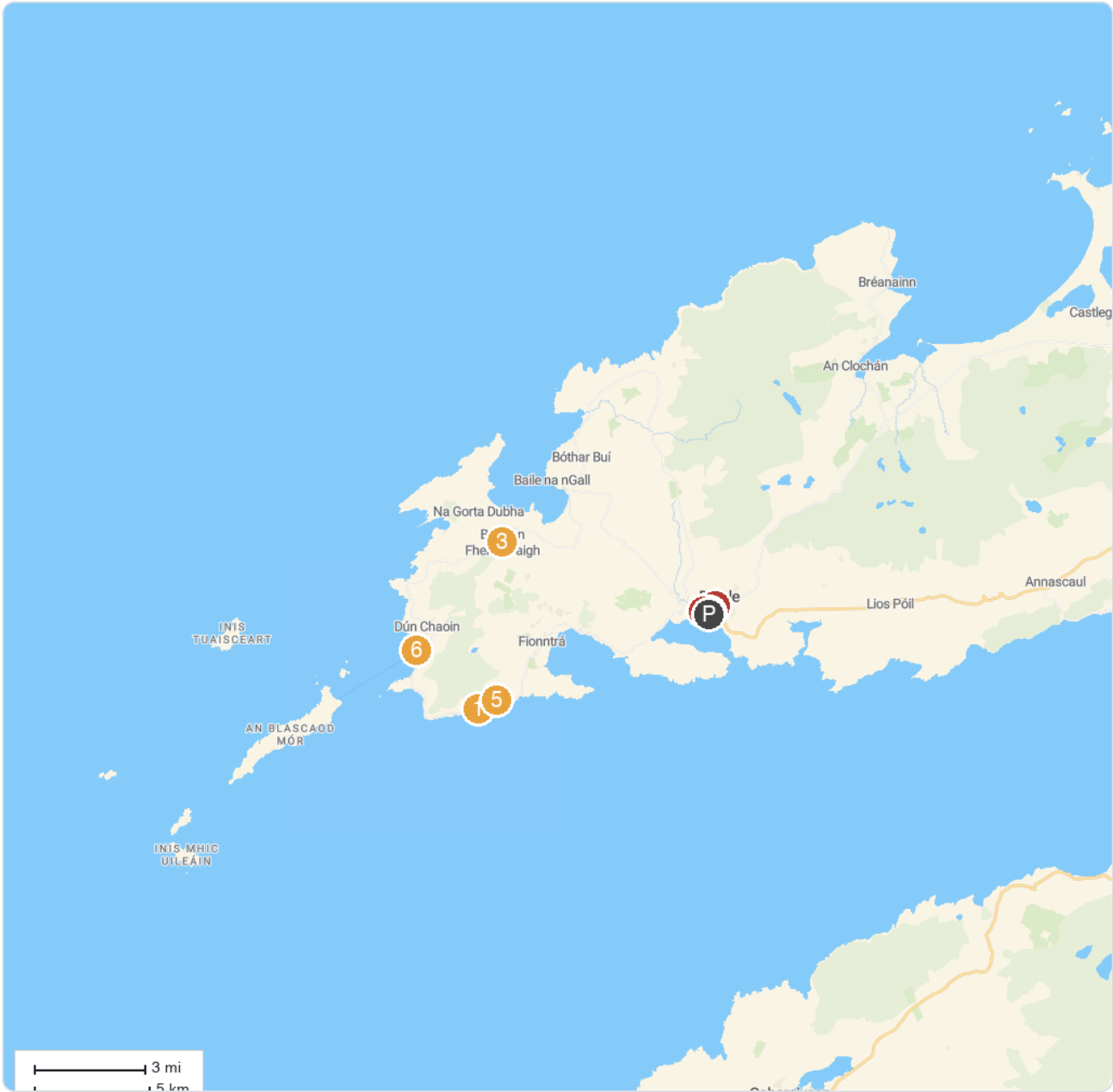
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Tender timing matters. Dingle calls are popular but tenders can be slow in chop. Collect your return tender ticket early and keep it safe — missing the last tender is a real risk.
- Book Slea Head transport in advance. Taxis and minibus tours fill up fast on port days. Pre-book from the ship or online — this is the #1 reason passengers miss out.
