TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Port-Musée Maritime Museum** — One of France's finest maritime museums, split across an indoor gallery and a living 'floating museum' in Port-Rhu...
- **Les Plomarc'h — Gallo-Roman Ruins & Coastal Path** — A 15-minute walk east of the tender pier leads to this protected headland with one of Europe's best-preserved...
- **Île Tristan at Low Tide** — A tidal island just off Port-Rhu, accessible on foot across a sandbar at low tide.
- **Kouign-Amann & Sardine Trail** — Douarnenez invented kouign-amann in 1860 — caramelised, buttery, impossible to resist.
- **Plage des Sables Blancs, Tréboul** — Cross the pedestrian footbridge over Port-Rhu into the resort quarter of Tréboul (25–30 min walk) to reach Brittany's...

BEST WALKS

- **Rosmeur to Port-Rhu Maritime Museum** 1.5 km · 15 min · Easy–Moderate — From the tender quay at Port de Rosmeur, follow the waterfront west past colourful fishermen's houses, then cut through the old town...
- **Coastal Path to Les Plomarc'h** 1.2 km · 15 min · Easy — Head east from the tender pier along the Sentier des Douaniers coastal path (GR34).

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Check the tide table before heading to Île Tristan. The sandbar path floods quickly — pick up the day's schedule at the tourist office near the port.
- Wear proper shoes. Douarnenez is steep and cobblestoned throughout. Flip-flops are a recipe for a twisted ankle on the climb from the tender pier.
