GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — docked at American Trust River's Edge Plaza / Port of Dubuque riverfront

Best For: River history, bluff scenery, Midwestern food, relaxed walkable days

Walk to center: 10–15 min to downtown Main Street; National River Museum is 3–5 min from dock

Don't Miss: National Mississippi River Museum & Fenelon Place Elevator (tri-state view)

Getting around: **Taxi** \$8–\$15 · **Rideshare** Uber, Lyft

TOP THINGS TO DO

- National Mississippi River Museum & Aquarium** — A Smithsonian-affiliated museum and aquarium exploring the ecology and history of America's great river.
 - Fenelon Place Elevator (Shortest Scenic Railway)** — Ride the world's shortest and steepest scenic funicular — a 189-foot cable car climb up a limestone bluff.
 - Field of Dreams Movie Site (Dyersville)** — Thirty minutes from Dubuque in Dyersville, Iowa, the original baseball
- diamond from the 1989 Kevin Costner film still...

 - Hotel Julien Dubuque — Al Capone Connection** — Downtown's elegant historic hotel was a known hideaway for Al Capone, who allegedly rented the entire 8th floor when...
 - Eagle Point Park — Bluff Panorama** — Perched on a high bluff at the northern edge of town, this beautifully landscaped park overlooks Lock & Dam No.

BEST WALKS

- Riverfront to Downtown Stroll** 1.2 miles · ~25 min one-way · Flat — Follow the Mississippi Riverwalk north past the National River Museum, outdoor sculpture exhibits, and the historic 1856 Shot Tower...
- Downtown to Fenelon Place Elevator** 0.6 miles · ~15 min from downtown · Moderate uphill — Walk up from Main Street through the Cathedral District to the base of the Fenelon Place Elevator.

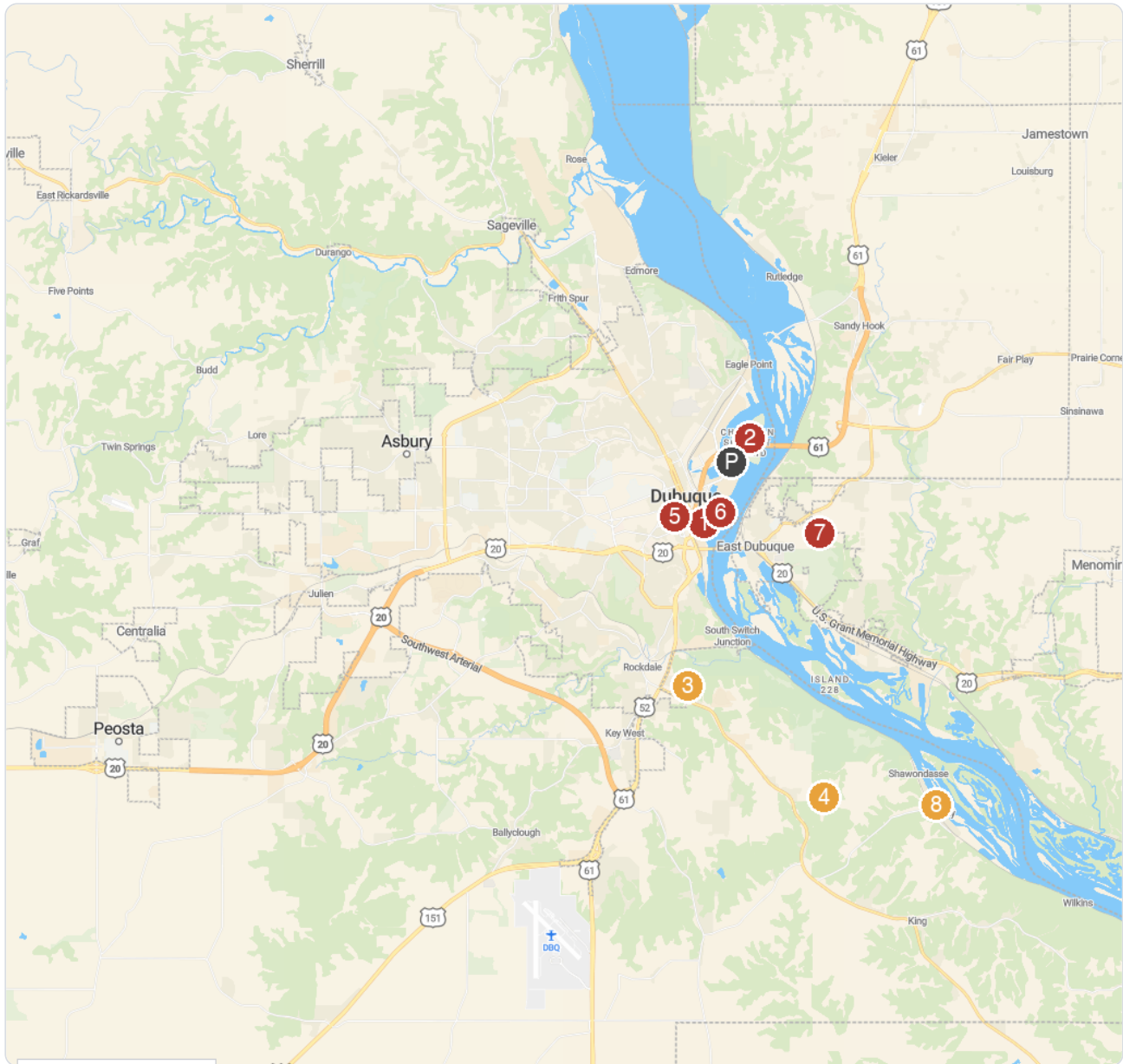
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Bring small cash. The Fenelon Place Elevator charges ~\$4 round trip and is cash only — ATMs are available downtown.

- 7 Dunleith Park District** Dunleith Park is a scenic park overlooking the Mississippi River.
- P Cruise port / terminal**

- 2 Q Casino + Resort** Q Casino is a casino, hotel, and entertainment complex.
- 4 Crystal Lake Cave** Crystal Lake Cave is a natural limestone cave for tours.
- 6 Dubuque Shot Tower** Dubuque Shot Tower is a historic tower for making lead shot.
- 8 Massey Marina and Park** Massey Marina is a public marina and park on the Mississippi.
