- **Landschaftspark Duisburg-Nord** — A decommissioned coal and steel plant turned public park is the city's crown jewel.
- **Museum Küppersmühle (MKM)** — Housed in a converted 19th-century grain mill right on the Inner Harbor, MKM holds one of Germany's finest collections...
- **Inner Harbor Boat Tour (Hafenrundfahrt)** — A 2-hour narrated cruise into the world's largest inland port, passing giant container terminals, coal docks, and...
- **Lehmbruck Museum** — A world-class sculpture museum in the leafy Kant Park dedicated to modern sculpture, featuring works by Lehmbruck...
- **Tiger & Turtle — Magic Mountain** — A walkable roller-coaster sculpture atop the Heinrich-Hildebrand-Höhe in Angerpark, southern Duisburg — an...

BEST WALKS

- **Inner Harbor & Schwanentor Stroll** 45 min · Flat · Free — An easy loop from the pier along the revitalised Innenhafen promenade, past the MKM grain mill, the Norman Foster buildings, and down...
- **City Center & Königstraße** 30 min · Flat · Free — Walk from the pier northwest through the pedestrian zone to the main shopping street and the Lehmbruck Museum in Kant Park — a...

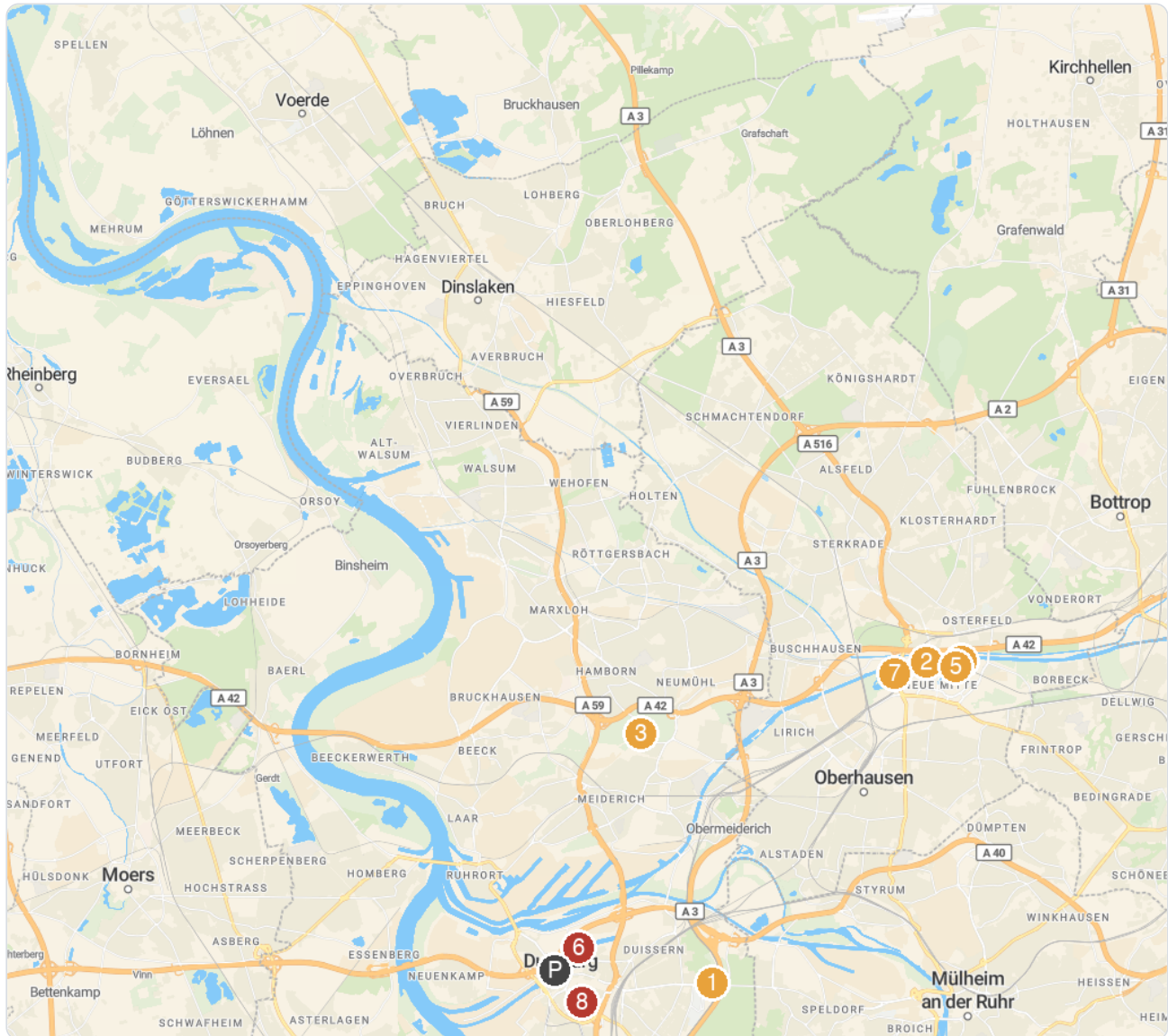
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Use the tram for Landschaftspark. It's 7 km from the pier — too far to walk. Tram 903 from Rathaus takes ~20 min and costs ~€3 each way. Buy tickets at the platform machine.
