GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — industrial port, 10–15 km from city center; shuttle bus required

Best For: WWII history, Dunkirk beaches, day trips to Bruges or Lille

Walk to center: Not walkable from pier — take ship shuttle or free city bus

Don't Miss: Musée Dunkerque 1940 in Bastion 32 and Malo-les-Bains beach

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Operation Dynamo: Bastion 32 Museum** — The Musée Dunkerque 1940 sits inside Bastion 32, the actual Allied command bunker during the evacuation.
- **Malo-les-Bains Beach & Evacuation Shoreline** — The wide sandy beach where soldiers waded into the sea in 1940 is today a lively resort with Art Nouveau villas, a...
- **Day Trip: Bruges, Belgium** — The 'Venice of the North' is just 45 minutes by road.
- **Lille City Tour** — France's Flemish capital is 45 minutes south — Grand Place, the 17th-century Vieille Bourse, UNESCO belfry, and...
- **WWI Flanders Battlefields & Ypres** — Ypres (Ieper) and the Flanders Fields are under an hour away — Menin Gate, Tyne Cot Cemetery, and In Flanders Fields...

BEST WALKS

- **City Center Heritage Walk** 1.5 km · 30–45 min · Easy, flat — From Place Jean Bart, admire the statue of privateer Jean Bart, then walk to Saint-Éloi Church (note WWII bullet holes in the...)
- **Malo-les-Bains Promenade** 2 km along the seafront · 40 min · Easy — Hop on free Bus C3 to Malo-les-Bains.

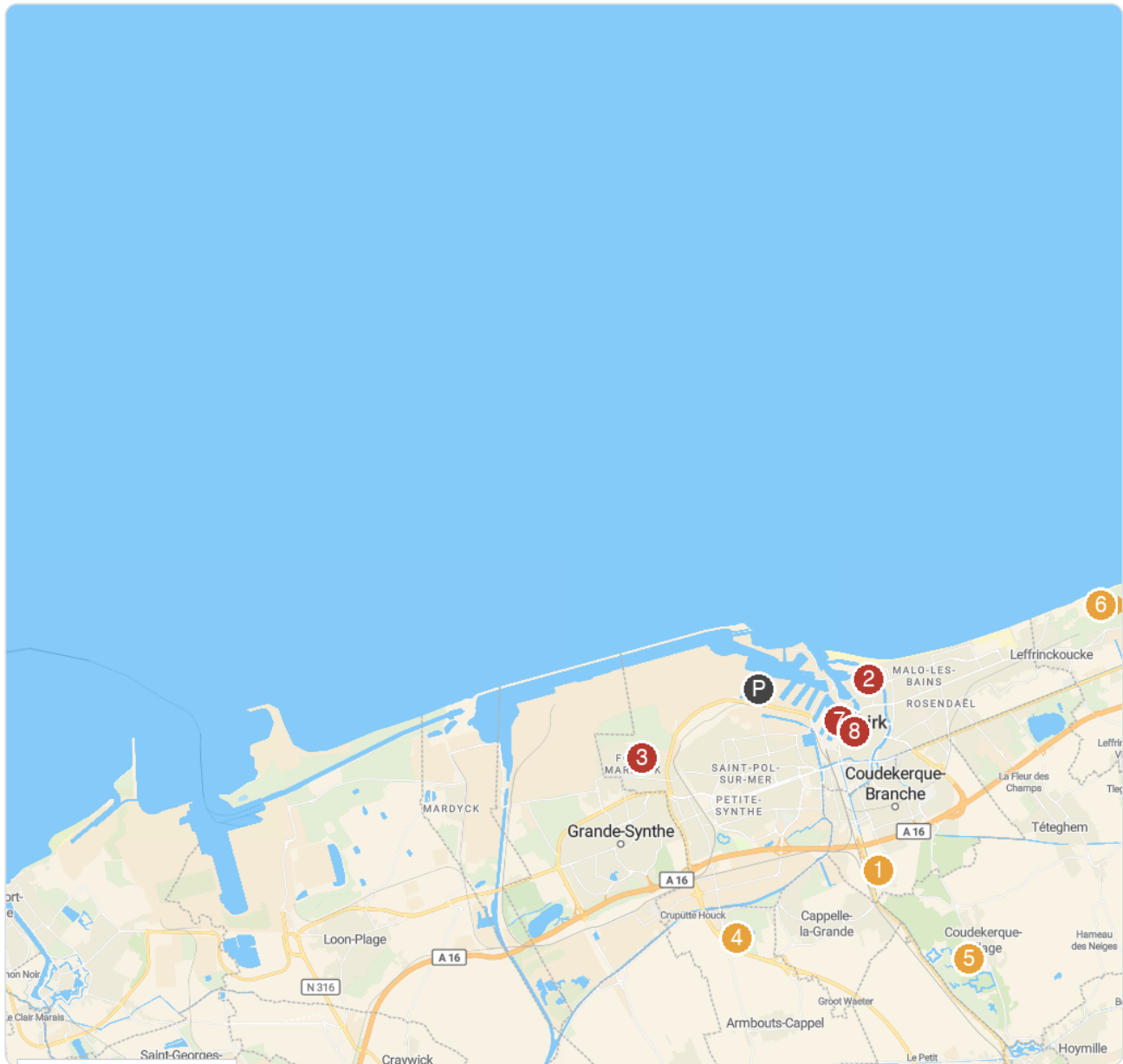
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Shuttle is essential. You cannot walk from the pier to the city — it's an industrial port. Confirm your cruise line's shuttle schedule and last departure time before exploring.
- All city buses are free. Dunkirk's DK'Bus Metro network charges zero fare. Bus C3 to Malo-les-Bains and several routes covering the city center are all no ticket, just board.

- 1 Fort Louis Park** A historic park built on the site of Fort Louis.
- 3 Bio-Topia Fort-Mardyck - Dunkerque** A zoological and botanical park for nature discovery.
- 5 Bois des Forts** A large forest perfect for walks and outdoor activities.
- 7 Port Museum of Dunkirk** Museum showcasing Dunkirk's maritime history and port heritage.
- P Cruise port / terminal**

- 2 Museum Dunkerque 1940 Operation Dynamo** Museum detailing the 1940 Dunkirk evacuation, Operation Dynamo.
- 4 Lac d'Armbouts-Cappel** A scenic lake offering walking paths and nature views.
- 6 Reserve Naturelle Dune Dewulf** A protected nature reserve featuring coastal dunes and wildlife.
- 8 Saint-Éloi Catholic Church at Dunkirk** A historic Catholic church with impressive Gothic architecture.
