TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Castle Ruins Hike** — Climb to the 12th-century Burgruine Dürnstein where King Richard the Lionheart was held for ransom in 1192–93.
- **Stift Dürnstein Abbey** — The famous blue-and-white Baroque tower belongs to a former Augustinian monastery.
- **Wachau Wine & Apricot Tasting** — The Wachau is famous for Grüner Veltliner and Riesling.
- **Danube Cycle Path Ride** — The flat, dedicated Danube Cycle Path runs directly past the ship.
- **Hauptstraße Stroll & Café Stop** — Wander the medieval main street, browse apricot liqueurs and Wachauer Laberl bread rolls at Bäckerei Schmidl, and...

BEST WALKS

- **Town Gate to Castle Ruins** 1.5 km round trip · 20–30 min up · Moderate (steep, rocky) — From the ship, pass through the medieval Kremser Tor gate and follow the signed castle trail uphill through the vineyards to the...
- **Riverside Promenade & Abbey** 1 km loop · 30–45 min · Easy (flat, paved) — Walk the flat riverside promenade from the ship toward the blue abbey tower, enter the monastery courtyard, then loop back along...

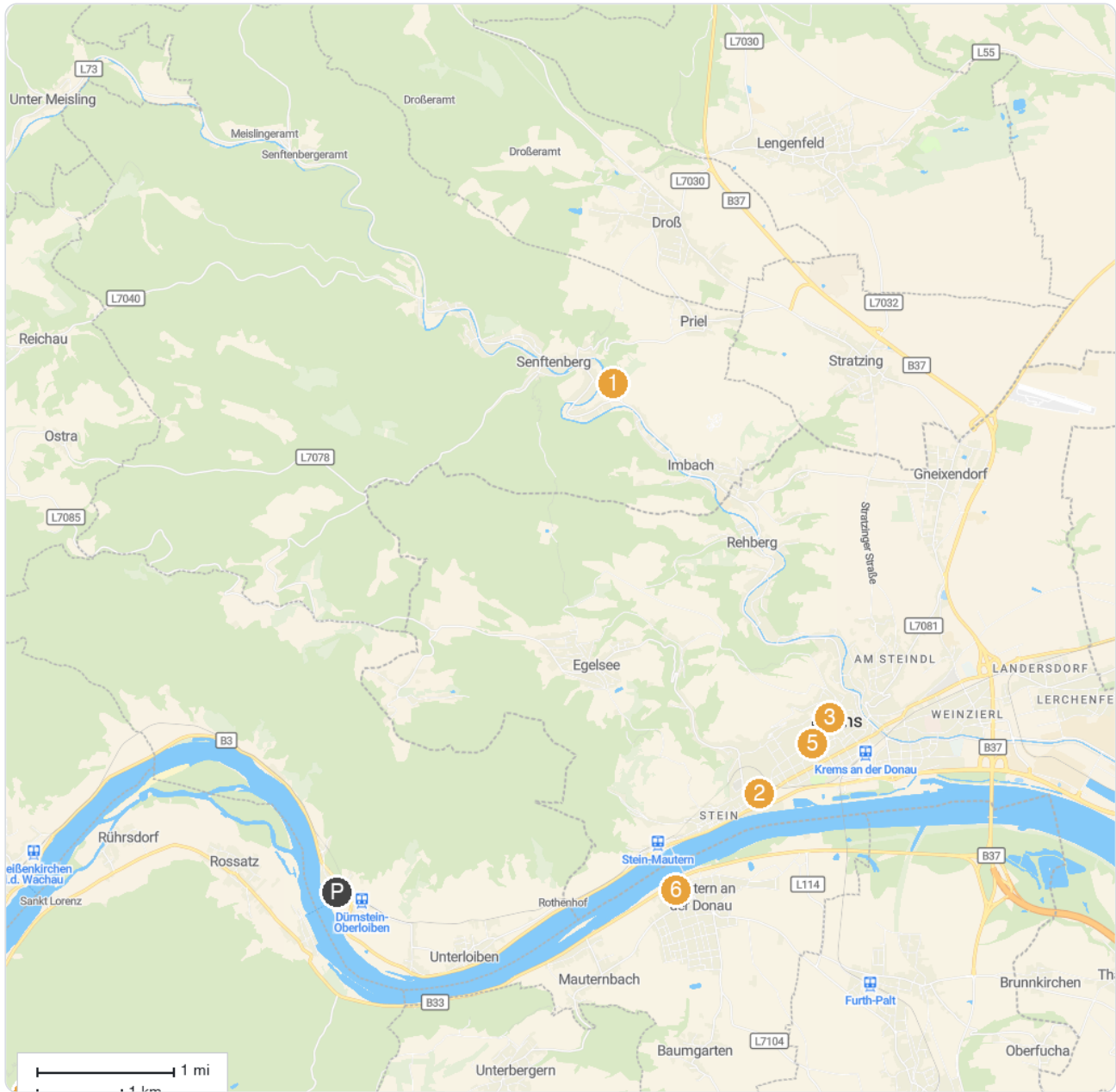
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
