

Easter Island (Hanga Roa), Chile

One of the most remote inhabited islands on Earth — a wind-swept triangle of volcanic craters, ceremonial platforms, and nearly a thousand brooding moai staring out from the Pacific. Your shore day here is genuinely unlike anywhere else.

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Rano Raraku & Ahu Tongariki** — The volcanic quarry where nearly all 900+ moai were carved, with dozens still half-finished in the hillside...
- **Rano Kau Crater & Orongo Birdman Village** — A steep-walled volcanic caldera filled with a reed-covered freshwater lake, and perched on its rim: Orongo, the...
- **Anakena Beach** — The island's only white-sand beach on the north coast, framed by palm trees and two ahu (platforms) — including a...
- **Ahu Akivi — Inland-Facing Moai** — The only ahu whose seven moai face the ocean rather than land — astronomically aligned to the setting sun at equinox.
- **Snorkeling & Diving** — Easter Island's waters are some of the clearest in the world — visibility can exceed 40 meters.

BEST WALKS

- **Hanga Roa waterfront & Ahu Tahai** ~2 km · 1 hr · easy — A short walk north along the coast from the tender dock brings you to Ahu Tahai — a restored coastal platform with three moai, one...
- **Hanga Roa town center** ~1 km · 30 min · easy — A stroll up Avenida Atamu Tekena, Hanga Roa's main street, past local restaurants, souvenir shops, and the Museo Antropológico...

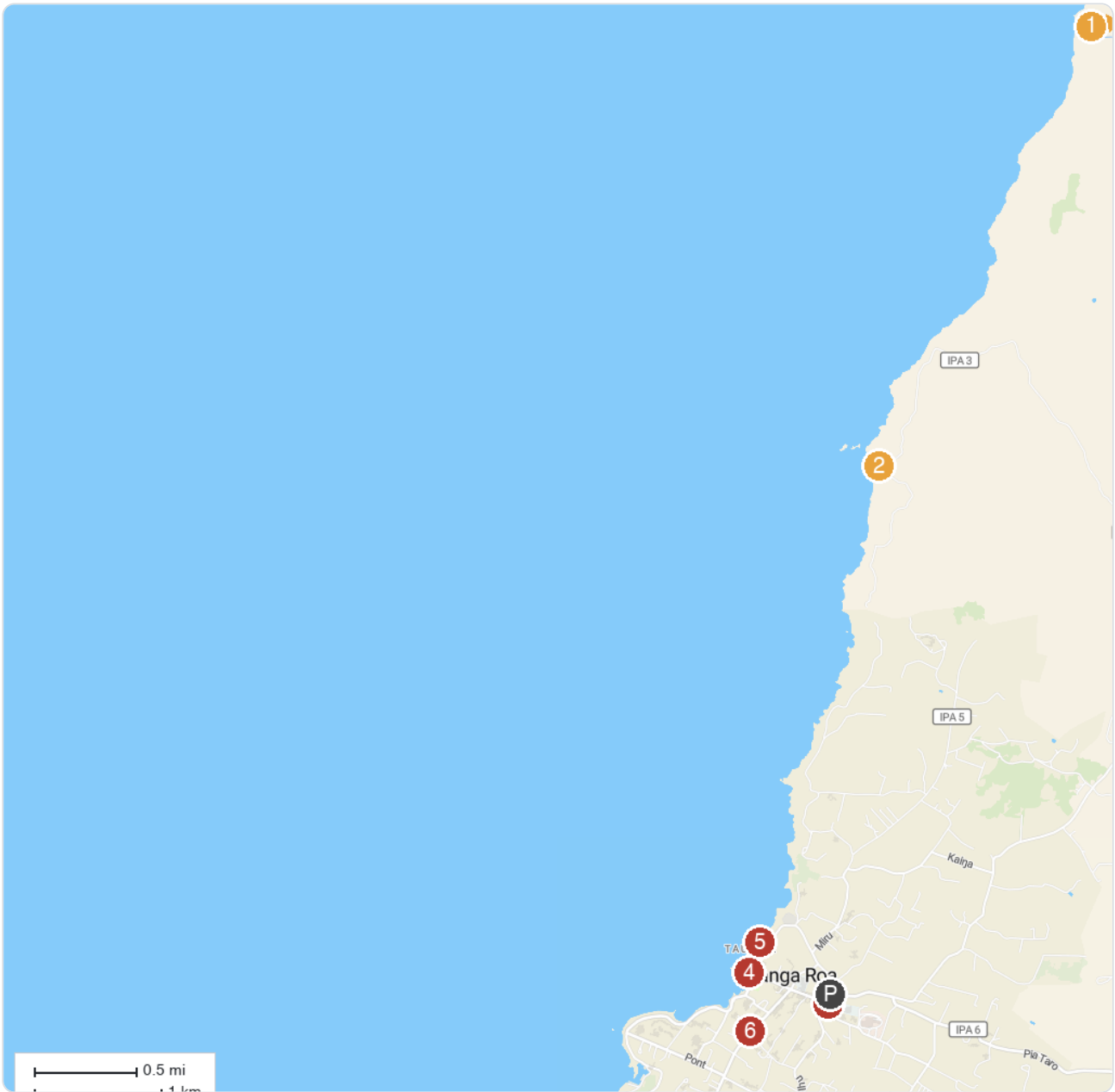
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Swells cancel calls. Easter Island is one of the most swell-affected tender ports in the world. If seas are running, the captain may abort the call entirely. Don't plan your trip...
- Buy your national park entry before you sail. Rapa Nui National Park (UNESCO) charges a \$100 USD entry fee per person, collected at the airport — ships usually handle this via...
