Docking: Breakwater Terminal (City Pier) — most ships dock; larger vessels may tender

Best For: Maritime history, seafood, tidal wildlife, Canadian border day trips

Walk to center: Under 2 min — pier opens directly onto Water Street

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Old Sow Whirlpool Boat Tour** — The largest natural whirlpool in the Western Hemisphere forms where 28-foot tides squeeze through the channel between...
 - Whale & Wildlife Cruise** — Passamaquoddy Bay hosts Minke, Finback, and Humpback whales, plus bald eagles, harbor seals, and porpoises.
- Water Street Historic Walk** — Eastport's 19th-century brick commercial district was once the sardine canning capital of the world.
 - Shackford Head State Park Hike** — Trails through coastal Maine forest lead to dramatic cliffs above Cobscook Bay.
 - Downeast Lobster & Craft Beer** — Quoddy Bay Lobster's seasonal deck and the Waco Diner (Maine's oldest, est.

BEST WALKS

- Water Street Stroll** 0.5 mi · 15 min · Easy — Walk the length of Eastport's historic brick main street from the City Pier north through galleries, the Tides Institute & Museum of...
- Shackford Head Loop** 3.5 mi rt · 90 min · Moderate — Head west from the pier along Water Street and Deep Cove Road to Shackford Head State Park.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Watch the tides. Eastport's tides swing 20–28 feet twice a day — the pier ladder and waterline will look completely different between morning and afternoon.
- Turn off data roaming. Your phone will likely ping Canadian towers (Rogers/Bell) across the border. Disable international data to avoid unexpected charges.
