

Eden, New South Wales, Australia

Perched on Twofold Bay — one of the Southern Hemisphere's deepest natural harbours — Eden punches well above its size. This small Sapphire Coast town was once Australia's whaling capital, and the legendary orca named Old Tom made it world-famous. Today it's all whale watching, red-cliff coastal trails, and oysters fresh from the bay.

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Whale Watching on Twofold Bay** — Twofold Bay's deep, sheltered water draws humpbacks and southern right whales on their annual migration.
- **Eden Killer Whale Museum** — Home to Old Tom — the skeleton of an orca who co-operated with local whalers for decades.
- **Beowa National Park & Red Cliffs** — Formerly Ben Boyd NP, Beowa protects striking red-and-white eroded cliffs, heath wildflowers, and tall eucalypt forests.
- **Kayaking the Pambula River** — Paddle the calm, tannin-dark Pambula River through coastal wetlands, spotting birdlife and the occasional dolphin.
- **Sydney Rock Oyster Tasting** — The Sapphire Coast is prime Sydney Rock Oyster country.

BEST WALKS

- **Snug Cove to Eden Lookout** 1.5 km • 20–25 min • Easy–moderate (gentle climb) — Walk from the cruise wharf along the waterfront, up through town past the Killer Whale Museum, and continue to Eden Rotary Lookout for...
- **Aslings Beach Stroll** 2 km return • 30 min • Easy — Head south from the town centre along Mitchell Street to reach Aslings Beach — a sheltered arc of sand good for a paddle or a sit-down.

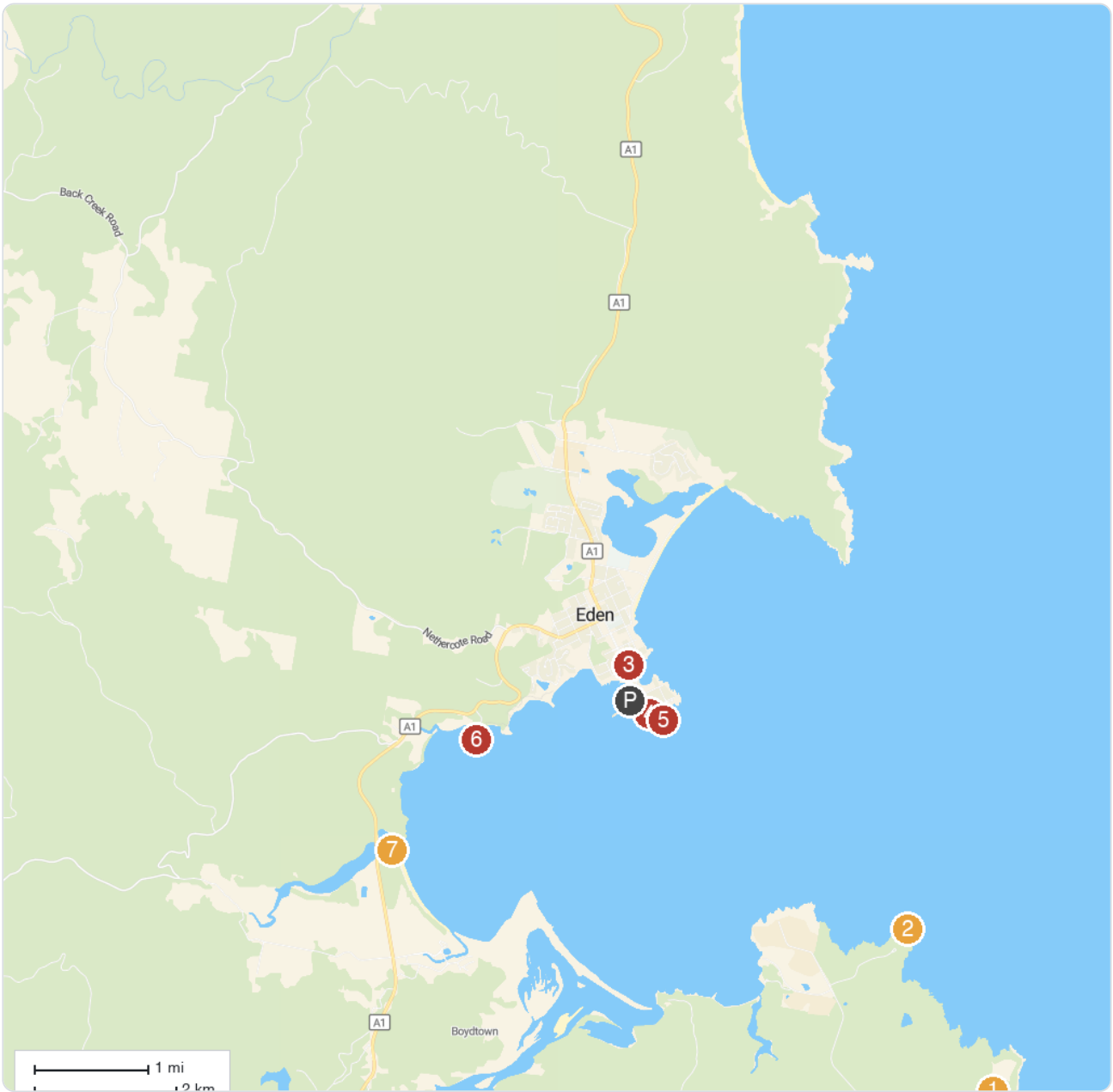
