TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Groningen City Highlights** — The provincial capital is a lively, compact city with a large student population.
- **Wadden Sea Mudflat Walk (Wadlopen)** — The Wadden Sea is a UNESCO World Heritage tidal ecosystem stretching along the northern Dutch coast.
- **Fortress Bourtange** — One of Europe's best-preserved star fortresses, Bourtange is a recreated 18th-century fortified village about 60 km...
- **Borkum Island Day Trip (Germany)** — The AG EMS ferry from Eemshaven reaches the German North Sea island of Borkum in about 50 minutes (or ~25 min by...
- **Groningen Canal Cruise** — Groningen has an extensive canal network.

BEST WALKS

- **Groningen Historic Center Loop** 3-4 km · Easy · ~1 hr — From Groningen Centraal Station, cross to the Groninger Museum, then walk north through Grote Markt to the Martinitoren.
- **Noorderplantsoen Park Stroll** 2 km · Easy · 30 min — A relaxed green escape in the city.

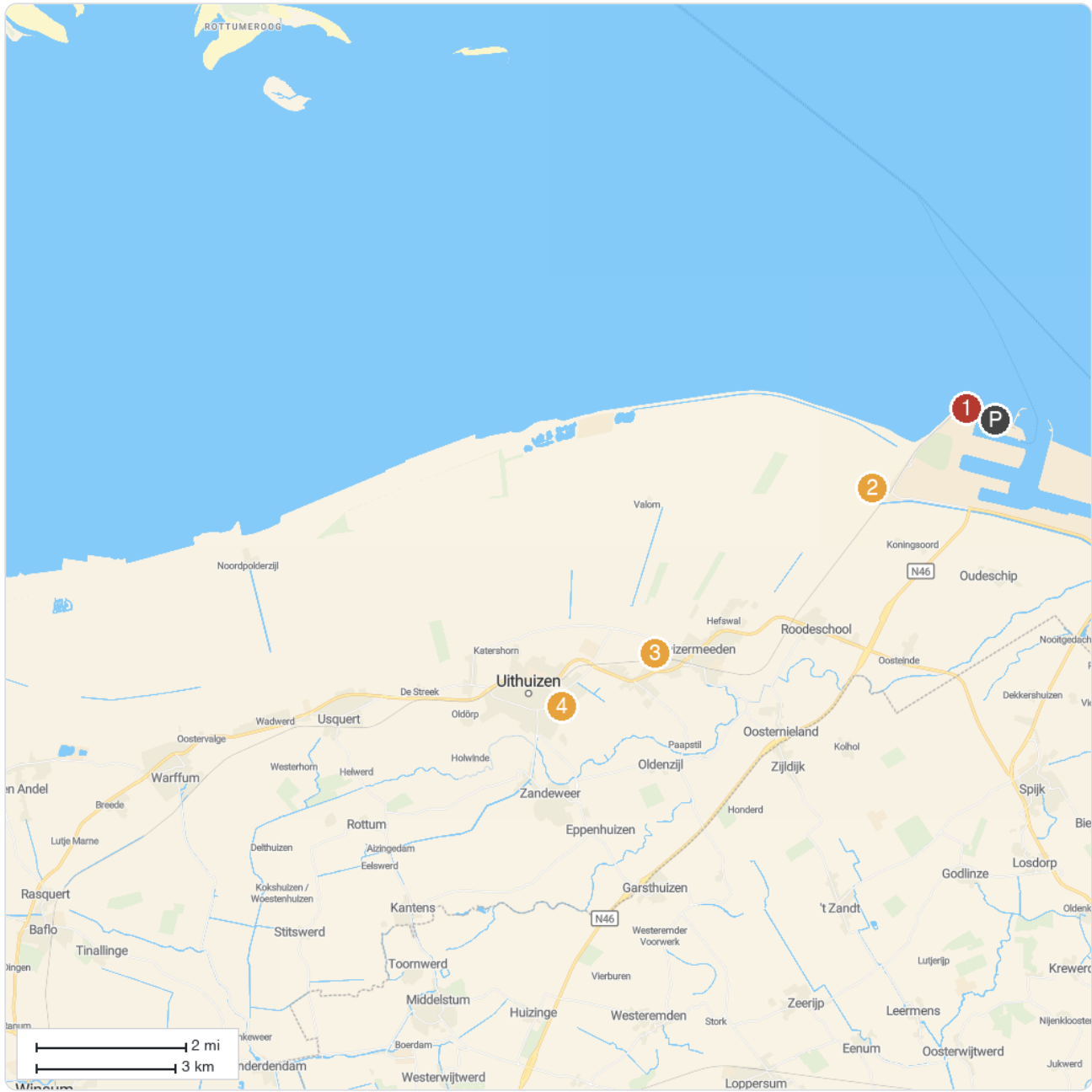
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Pre-book transport. Taxis fill up fast at the port gate. Arrange a private transfer or confirm bus times before you go ashore — there is nothing at the pier to wait around for.
- Budget your time carefully. The 30-40 min transfer each way to Groningen eats into a shorter port call — if you have less than 7 hours, a city visit is still doable but skip the...
