Docking: Pier — Dampskipskaaien, steps from the town centre

- Trollpikken & Magma Geopark** — Egersund's headline attraction — a naturally sculpted phallic rock pillar rising from lunar anorthosite landscape...
- Historic Wooden Town Walk** — Self-guided walk through Strandgaten and the medieval Haugen quarter, home to one of Norway's largest concentrations of...
- Egersund Fayancemuseum** — Tells the story of Egersund's famed fayence (tin-glazed pottery) factory, which produced distinctive stoneware for 132...
- Eigerøy Lighthouse Hike** — Hike across Eigerøy island's striking anorthosite plateau — often compared to a moonscape — to reach Norway's oldest...
- Berentsen Distillery & Brewery** — A family-owned institution since 1899, Berentsen's produces craft beer, traditional Norwegian cider, and award-winning...

BEST WALKS

- Harbour & Wooden Town Loop** 2.5 km · 45–60 min · Easy · Free — From the cruise pier walk along the waterfront to Torget (main square), then into the Haugen quarter to see the painted wooden houses...
- Varberg Hill Viewpoint** 3 km round trip · 1 hr · Easy–moderate · Free — A short climb up Varberg hill behind the town rewards with panoramic views over the harbour, islands, and the Rogaland coastline.

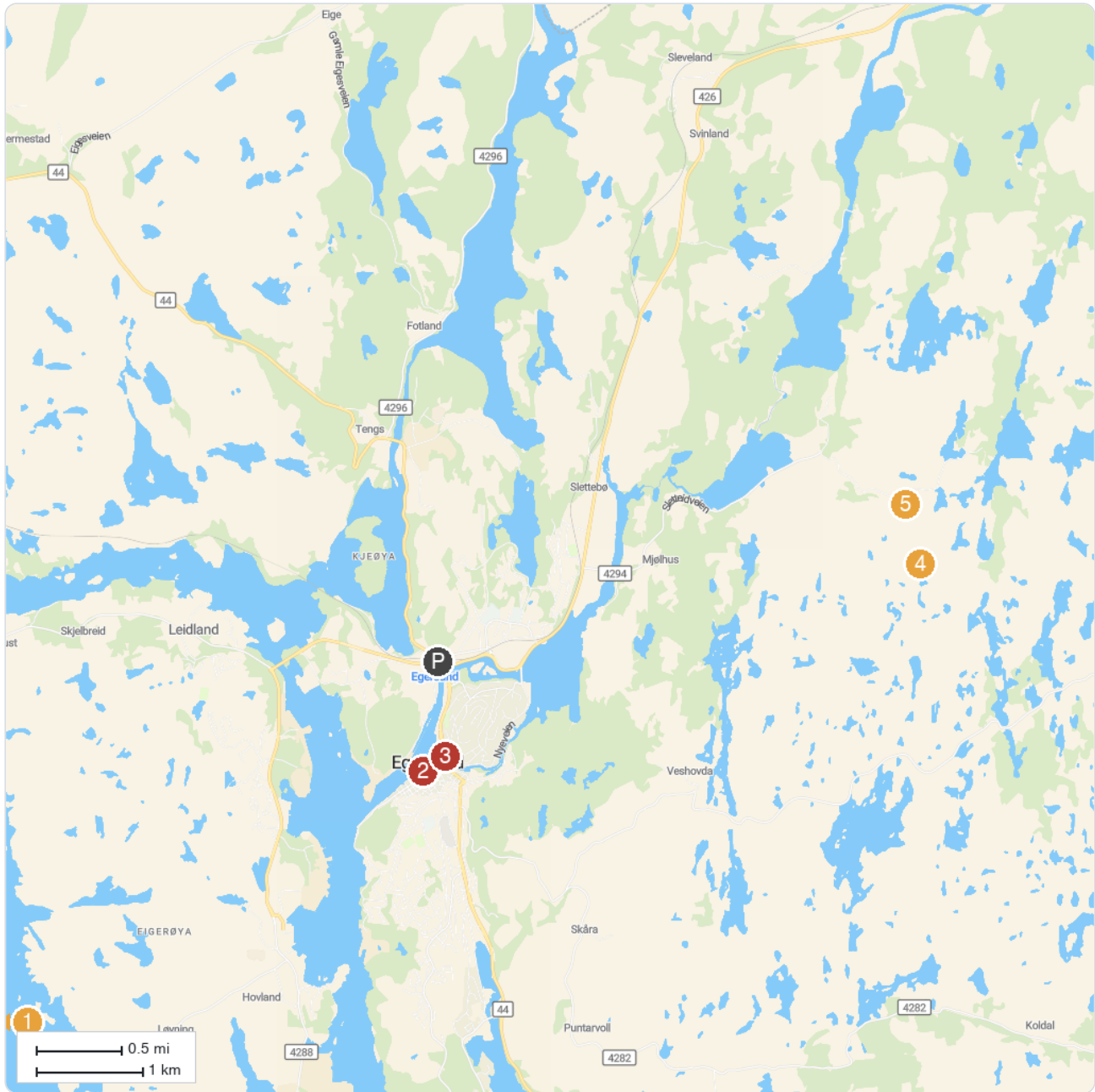
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
