

Eidfjord, Vestland, Norway

A village of 900 people at the inner end of the Hardangerfjord, Eidfjord punches well above its size — it's the launch pad for Europe's most dramatic waterfall and Norway's vast high-mountain plateau.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — ships dock in the village center; no tendering

Best For: Waterfalls, fjord scenery, Viking history, mountain hikes

Walk to center: 2–3 min flat walk from pier to cafes and shops

Don't Miss: Vøringsfossen waterfall — 182 m freefall into Måbødalen canyon

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  150–300 NOK (short trips)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Vøringsfossen Waterfall** — Norway's most visited waterfall drops 182 m into the Måbødalen canyon.
- Hardangervidda Plateau Drive** — Europe's largest high-mountain plateau sits above Eidfjord at 1,100 m.
- Hereid Viking Burial Ground** — Western Norway's largest Iron Age and Viking burial ground (c.
- Hardangervidda Nature Center** — World-class interactive museum covering Norwegian climate, wildlife, and nature, with a stunning 225° panoramic cinema.
- Fjord Kayaking** — Paddle on the glass-flat waters of the inner Hardangerfjord, surrounded by walls of rock rising over 1,000 m.

BEST WALKS

- Village & River Walk** 2 km round-trip · Flat · 30–40 min — Follow the Eio River from the pier through the village center to the old church (Gamlekyrkja, built 1309) and back along the shoreline...
- Hereid Viking Graves** 3 km round-trip · Moderate uphill · 50–60 min — A steady uphill walk leads to Western Norway's largest Iron Age and Viking burial ground, with panoramic views of the fjord and...

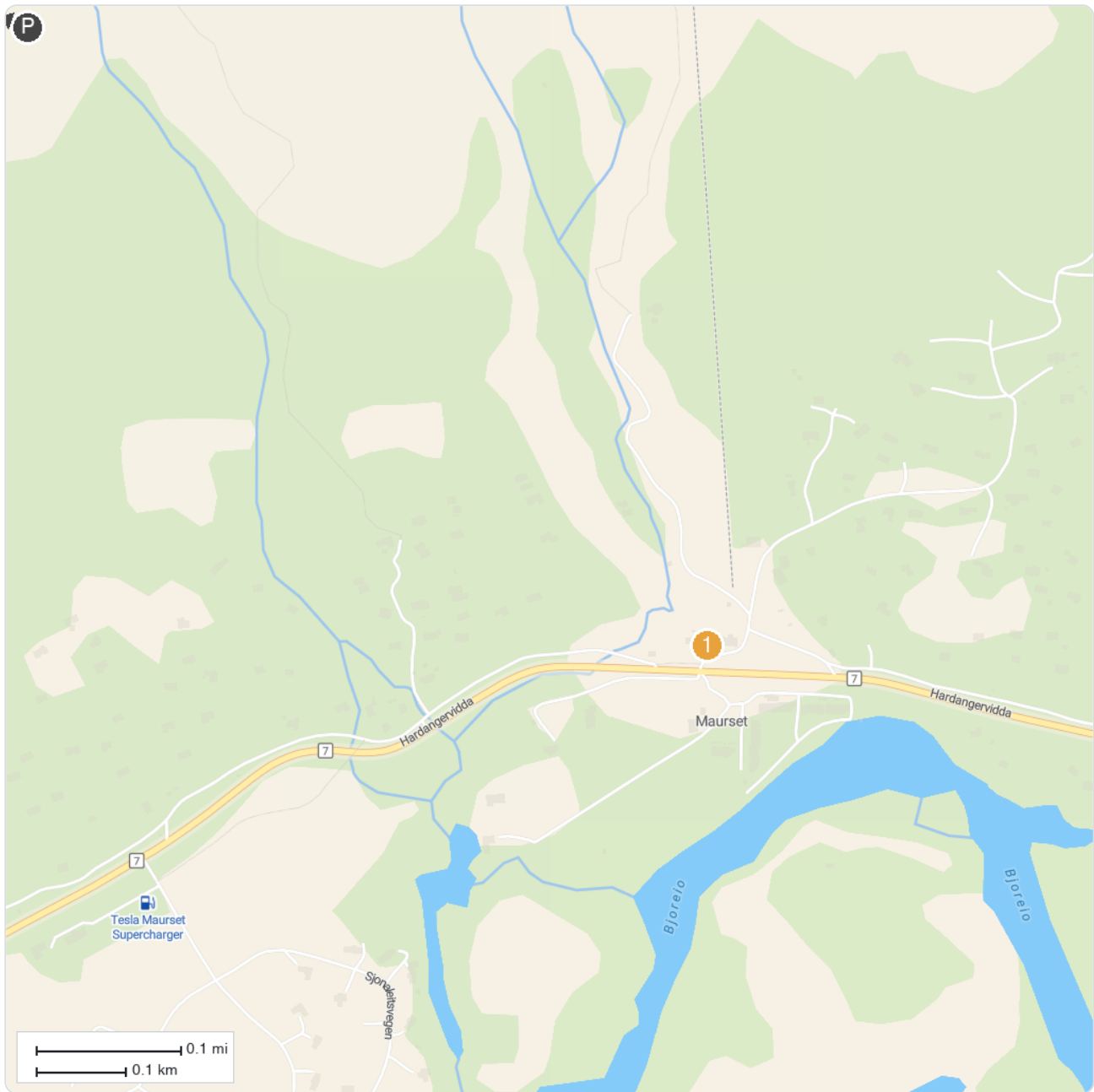
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Book Vøringsfossen transport early. Taxis are nearly non-existent. The Hardanger Fjordtoppen shuttle and ship excursions fill up — pre-book online or head straight to the pier...
- Norway is cashless. Visa and Mastercard work everywhere — Troll Train, kayak hire, the supermarket. AMEX is hit-or-miss. You don't need any NOK cash
