GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender to ferry quay; no dedicated cruise terminal

Best For: Scenic drives, Eagle Road viewpoints, fjord photography

Walk to village: Immediate — village surrounds the quay

Don't Miss: Ørnevegen (Eagle Road) hairpin bends & Geirangerfjord views

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Ørnevegen — Eagle Road Drive** — Eleven spectacular hairpin bends climbing out of the Eidsdal valley with panoramic views over Geirangerfjord and the...
- **Geirangerfjord UNESCO Cruise or Bus** — Descend the Eagle Road into Geiranger and take a fjord cruise past towering waterfalls and sheer cliffs.
- **Gudbrandsjuvet Gorge** — A dramatic river gorge in the Valldalen valley, reached via the Eidsdal–Linge ferry then about 15 km up the valley...
- **Eidsdal–Linge Ferry Crossing** — Hop the local car ferry across Norddalsfjorden to Linge — a 10-minute crossing that drops you in the middle of the...
- **Herdalssetra Mountain Farm** — The historic summer mountain farm at Herdalssetra sits high above the Norddal valley, reached by a steep toll road.

BEST WALKS

- **Village & Quay Stroll** 30 min · Flat · Free — From the ferry quay, walk along the waterfront past the local store and through the village.
- **Start of the Eagle Road Viewpoint** 45 min · Moderate incline · Free — Walk the first hairpin bend of the Eagle Road (Ørnevegen/RV63) above the village for a taste of the famous views without needing a...
