The smallest and most untamed of the Canary Islands, El Hierro trades beach resorts for ancient laurel forests, surreal wind-twisted junipers, and crystalline volcanic rock pools. A UNESCO Biosphere Reserve running mostly on wind and water power, it rewards curious cruisers willing to venture beyond the pier.

- **Guinea Ecomuseum & Giant Lizard Center** — A preserved stone village showing Bimbaches indigenous and early settler life, combined with a breeding center for the...
- **Mirador de la Peña** — César Manrique's signature viewpoint perched 700 m above the sweeping El Golfo valley.
- **Scuba Diving — Mar de las Calmas Reserve** — The southern coast's protected Sea of Calms is one of Europe's premier dive sites — volcanic pinnacles, rays, and...

BEST WALKS

- **La Llanía Laurel Forest Loop** 1.5-2 hrs • Easy • Free — A circular trail through ancient mossy laurisilva (laurel forest) — misty, fairy-tale quiet, and dramatically different from the arid...
- **Playa de Tacorón Coastal Walk** 1 hr • Easy • Free — A short walk along the southern volcanic coast to a sheltered snorkeling cove with red rock formations and glassy water.

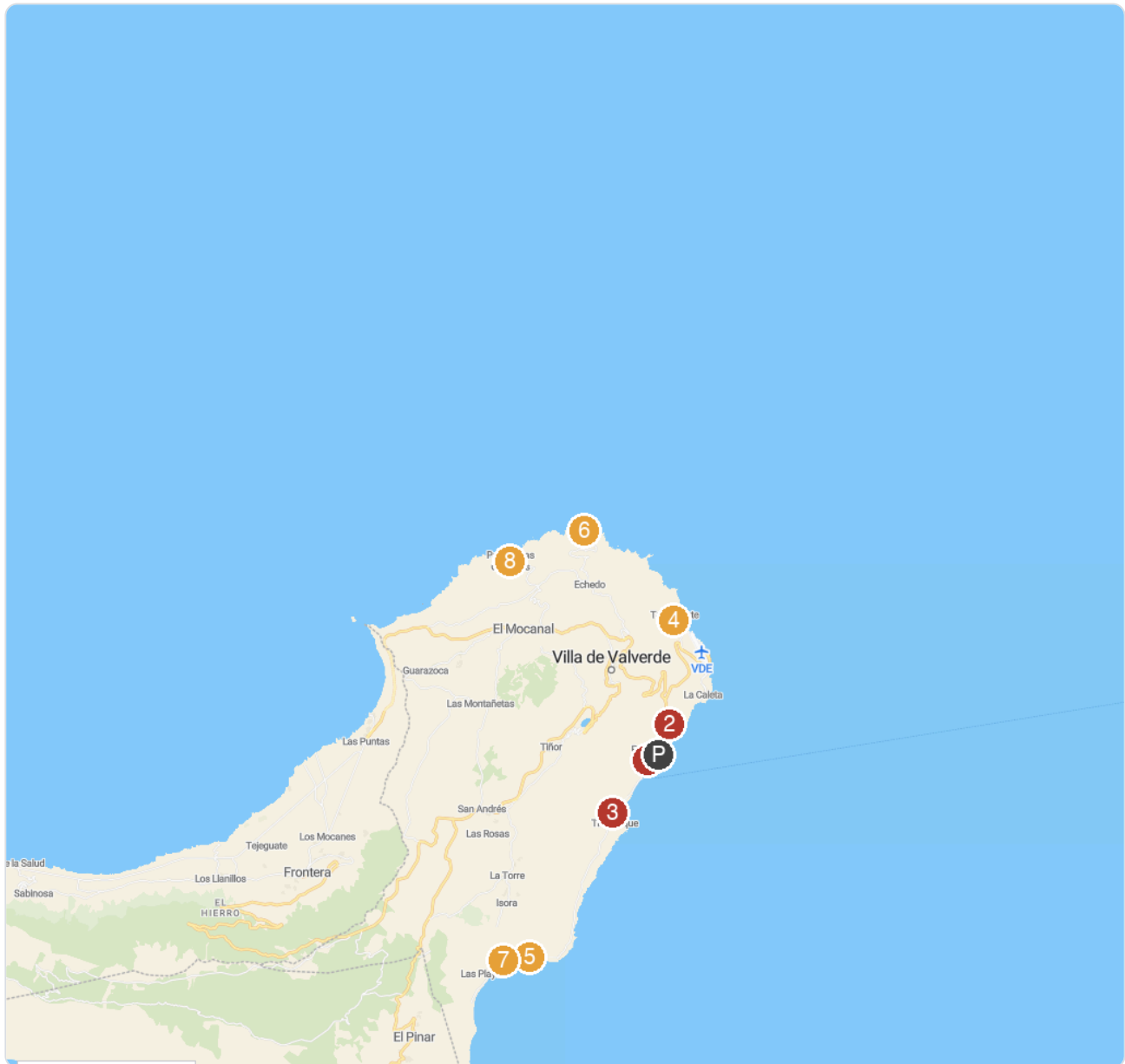
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
