GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — ships dock alongside the Rhine promenade; no tender

Best For: Wine lovers, history, roses, relaxed Rhine atmosphere

Walk to center: 2–5 min flat walk to Electoral Castle and Old Town

Don't Miss: Riesling or Sekt at the riverside wine booth, rose gardens in the castle courtyard

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Electoral Castle & Gutenberg Tower** — The 14th-century Kurfürstliche Burg sits minutes from the pier.
- **Rheingau Riesling Wine Tasting** — The Rhine promenade wine booth rotates local Rheingau wineries — pour a glass of chilled Riesling or traditional-method...
- **Kloster Eberbach Abbey** — A remarkably preserved 12th-century Cistercian monastery in the forested hills above Eltville.
- **Vineyard Walk to Schloss Vollrads** — Follow footpaths up through Rheingau Riesling vineyards to Schloss Vollrads, one of Germany's oldest wine estates, with...
- **Eltville Old Town Stroll** — Wander the Altstadt's network of cobblestone lanes past half-timbered houses, the Gothic Parish Church of St.

BEST WALKS

- **Promenade to Castle Rose Garden** 1 km · 15 min · flat — Walk upstream along the Rhine Promenade from the pier, passing the Sebastian Tower to the Electoral Castle courtyard, where more than...
- **Old Town Loop** 1.5 km · 25 min · cobblestones — From the castle, loop through the Altstadt via the Martinstor gate, along Schmittstraße past timber-framed merchants' houses, and back...

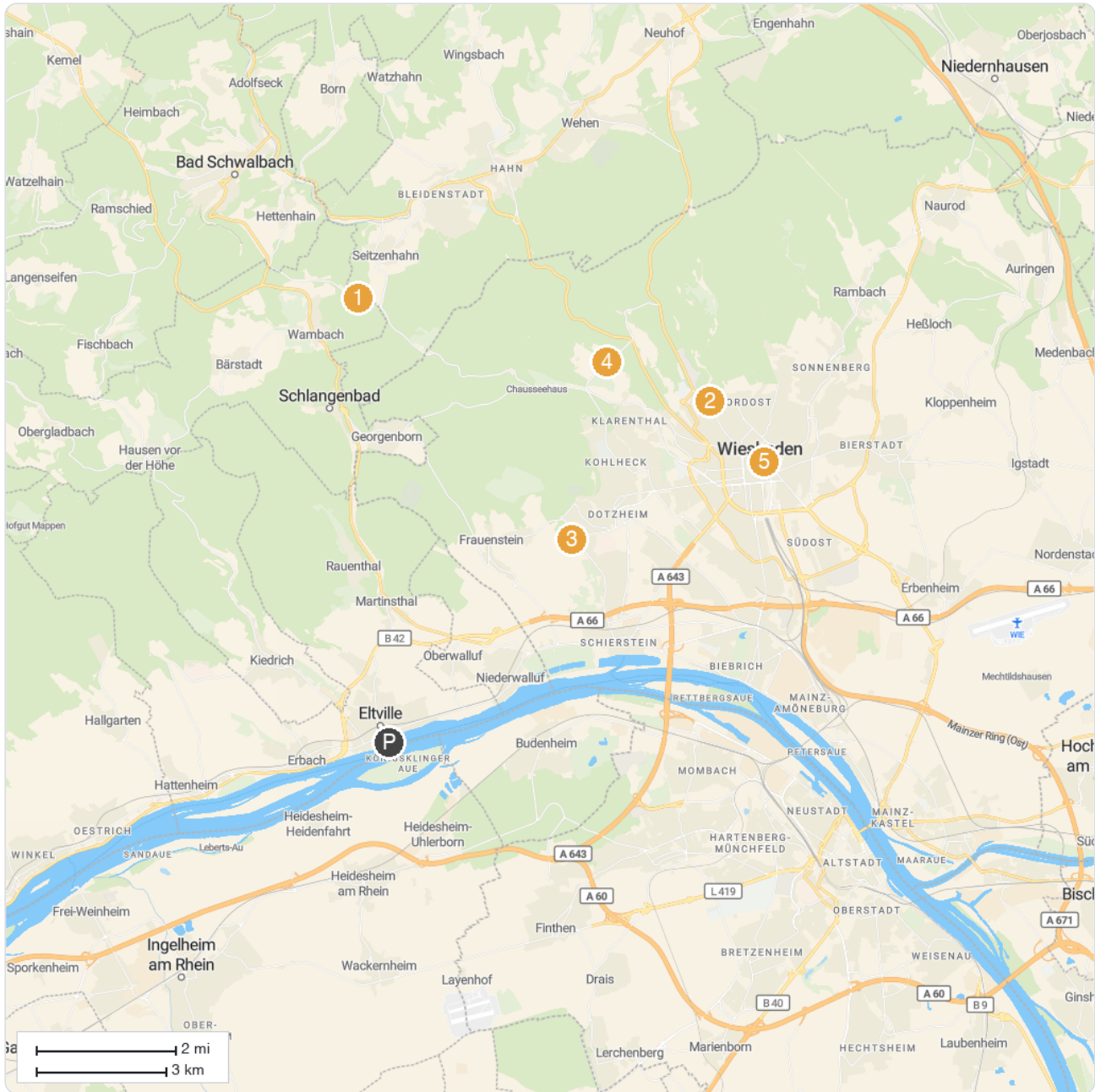
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Bring cash. The riverside wine booth and many traditional Gutsschänken (winery taverns) accept only cash or German EC cards, not international credit cards.
- Best in June–July. Rose season peaks in June; the annual Rose Days (Rosentage) festival takes place then. Over 10,000 rose bushes bloom throughout town.
- Sunday closures. Shops in the Altstadt close on Sundays under German trading laws. Restaurants, wine booths, and the castle gardens remain open.
