GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Docked on Rhine Promenade — no tender required

Walk to center: 0–10 min; promenade is directly at the gangway

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Emmerich Rhine Bridge Walk** — Germany's longest road suspension bridge stretches 803 metres across the Rhine (500 m main span).
- Rheinmuseum (Rhine Museum)** — Just steps from the promenade, this engaging museum covers 2,000 years of Rhine shipping with 150+ ship models, a WWII...
- PAN Kunstforum Poster Museum** — The former Lohmann chocolate factory now houses one of Europe's great poster-art collections — around 95,000 graphic...
- Elten Hill & St. Vitus Church** — A short taxi ride takes you to Hoch-Elten, a rare hilltop above the flat Rhine plain, where a Romanesque church offers...
- Bike to the Dutch Border** — The flat Rhine cycle path (*Rheinradweg*) leads across the border in under 30 minutes to the Dutch market town of...

BEST WALKS

- Rhine Promenade Stroll** 2 km · 30–40 min · Flat · Free — Walk the full length of the Lower Rhine's longest riverside promenade from the town center westward toward the suspension bridge.
- Old Town Loop** 1.5 km · 25 min · Flat · Free — From the promenade, cut inland to St.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

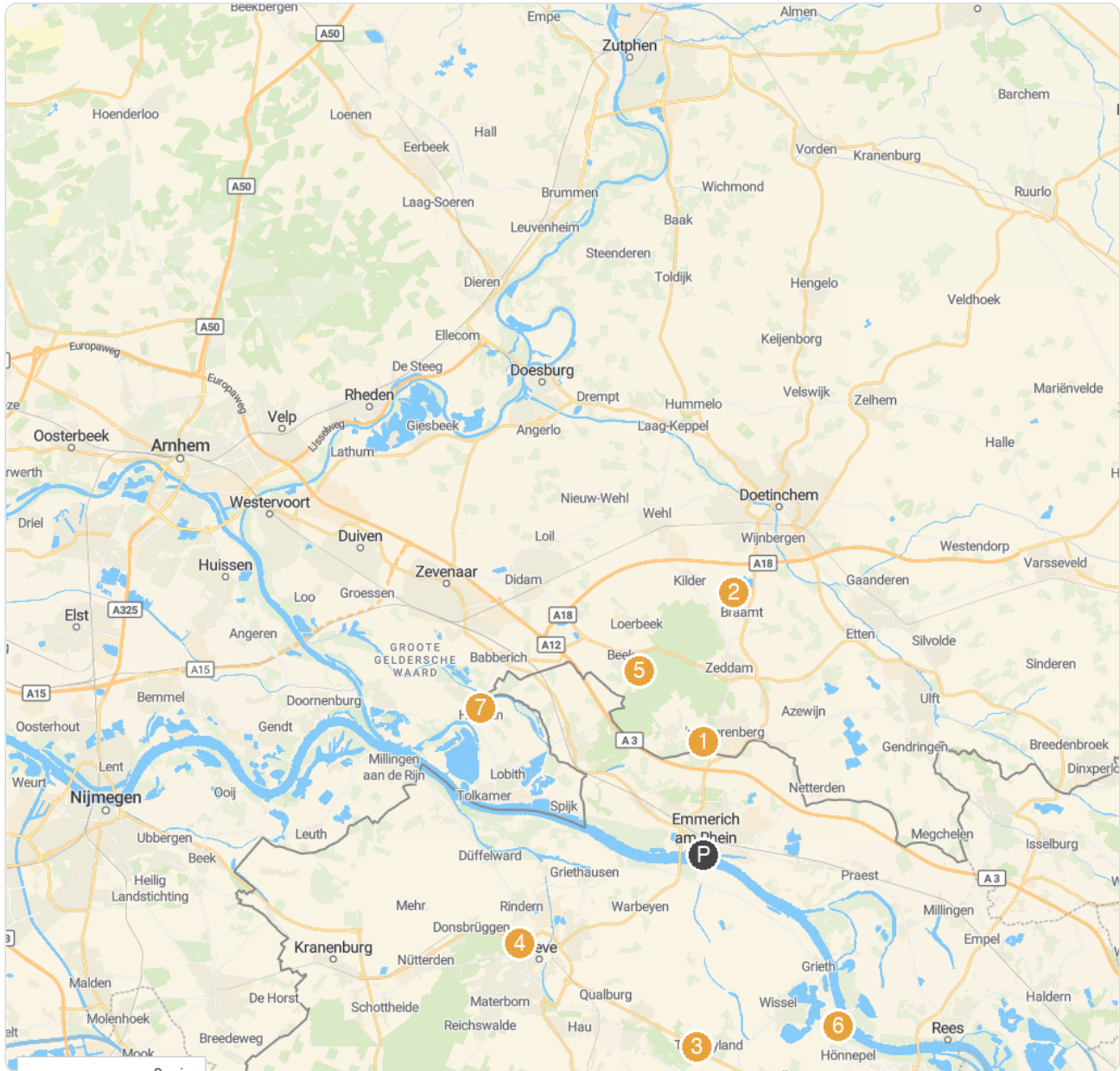
- Promenade at your feet: You step off the gangway directly onto the Rhine Promenade — no transport needed to start exploring.
- Bring or rent a bike: The Rhine cycle path is superb here. Many river ships carry bikes; if yours does, take one — the Dutch border crossing is flat and rewarding
