

Ensenada, Baja California, Mexico

Ensenada punches above its weight: ships dock right at the edge of downtown, putting seafood stalls, margarita birthplace lore, and the gateway to Baja's wine country all within a short walk or cab ride.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — no tender required; walk off directly

Walk to center: 15–20 min flat walk or short shuttle to Calle Primera

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **La Bufadora Marine Geyser** — One of North America's largest marine geysers blasts seawater up to 100 feet into the air through a sea cave blowhole.
- **Valle de Guadalupe Wine Tour** — Baja's acclaimed wine region produces the large majority of Mexico's wine (commonly cited at 70–90%).
- **ATV & Off-Road at Las Cañadas** — Las Cañadas Off-Road Park offers ATV trails through canyons and hills, often combined with ziplines, horseback riding...
- **Riviera Cultural Center & Downtown Walk** — The ornate Riviera del Pacífico (now Centro Social, Cívico y Cultural Riviera) was once a casino frequented by Al...
- **Fish Taco & Tequila Tasting** — Ensenada is ground zero for Baja-style fish tacos.

BEST WALKS

- **Malecón to Calle Primera Loop** 2–3 km · 45–60 min · Easy · Flat — Walk north along the waterfront Malecón promenade past the giant flagpole and Plaza Cívica (home to the three golden heads of Juárez...

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

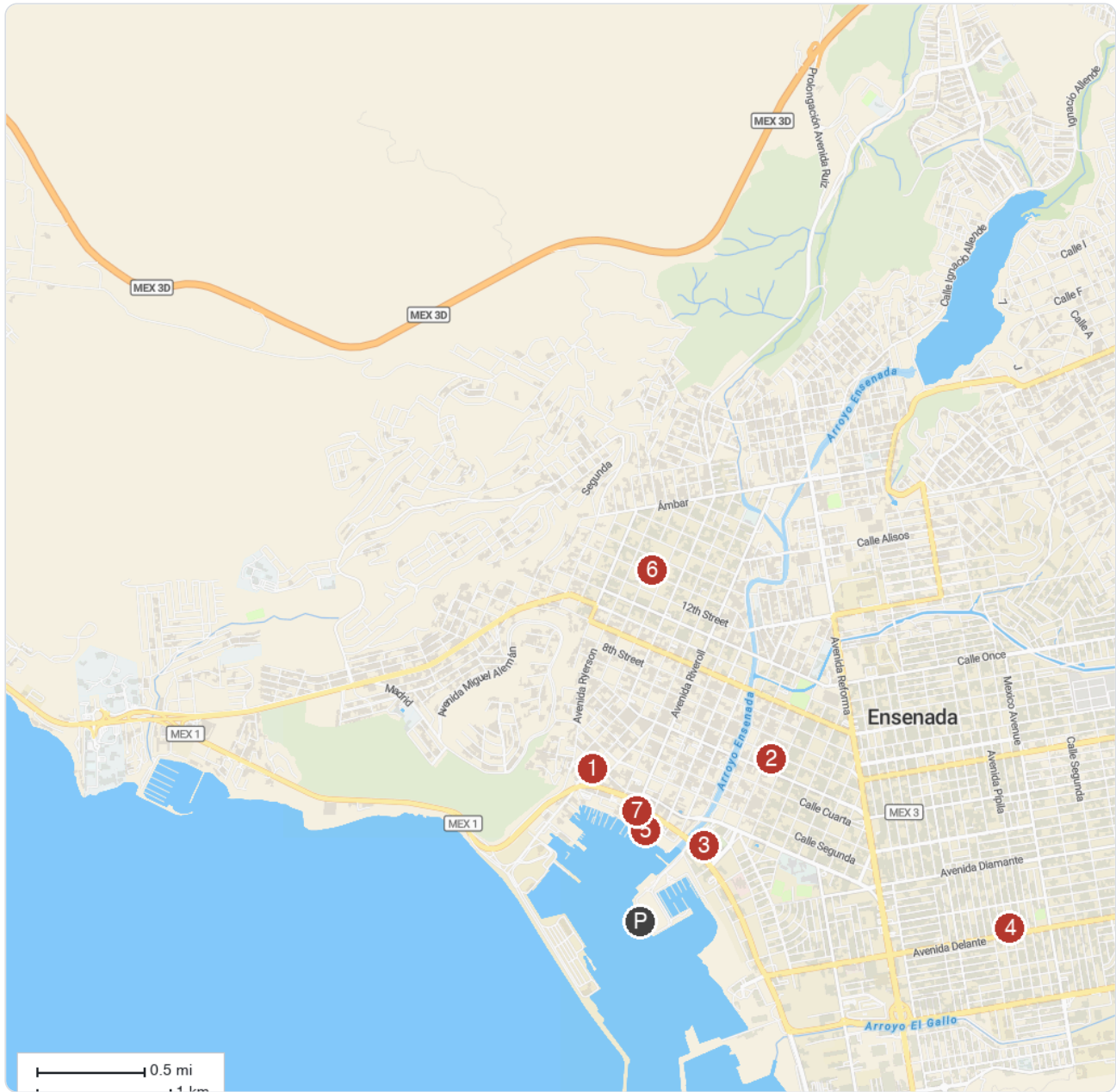
- Both currencies work downtown. Pesos get you better rates at markets and street stalls; USD is widely accepted in tourist shops but often at a poor exchange rate. Hit an ATM for...
- Uber can't enter the port gate. Walk to the terminal exit before requesting a ride. Taxis at the gate are plentiful and generally safe — agree on a price before you get in.

Back to La Bufadora and Valle de Guadalupe in advance. Both are 40–45 minutes out. Last-minute taxis at the gate can work, but
