

Eresfjord, Møre og Romsdal, Norway

A hidden fjord village of ~380 souls where the Eira salmon river flows from Eikesdalsvatnet lake down to the fjord — unspoiled, serene, and dramatically framed by peaks rising straight from the water.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — ships anchor in the fjord; boats ferry to the local marina

Best For: Dramatic fjord scenery, waterfall excursions, and authentic village calm

Walk to center: 5–10 min from tender landing to Sira Church and Coop store

Don't Miss: Mardalsfossen waterfall (June 20–Aug 20 only) and the Eira riverside walk

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  ~700 NOK/hr (≈ USD) ·  **Rideshare**  not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Mardalsfossen Waterfall Hike** — One of Europe's tallest waterfalls with a free-fall of 297 m (975 ft).
- **Eikesdalen Valley & Lake Cruise** — Drive or boat along Eikesdalsvatnet, a 18 km narrow lake hemmed by 1,800 m walls of rock.
- **Aursjøvegen Mountain Road (4x4)** — A wild, unpaved mountain road of hairpin turns and vertiginous drops — sometimes called the wilder cousin of Trollstigen.
- **Bjørnstjerne Bjørnson's Childhood Home** — Nobel Prize-winning Norwegian author Bjørnstjerne Bjørnson grew up at Nesset Vicarage nearby.
- **Goksøyra Summit Hike** — A full-day hike to the Goksøyra summit (13.5 km out-and-back, 1,220 m elevation gain) with a panoramic view over...

BEST WALKS

- **Eira River & Village Walk** ~2 km | Easy | 30–45 min — From the marina, follow the flat path alongside the crystal-clear Eira River — famous for Atlantic salmon.
- **Fjord Shoreline Stroll** ~1.5 km | Easy | 20–30 min — Walk the fjord-side path with your ship anchored in the water ahead of you, flanked by the peak of Skjorta rising to the east.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Waterfall timing is everything. Mardalsfossen only runs at full power June 20–August 20. Outside those dates, the hydroelectric dam cuts the flow to a trickle — still a nice hike...
- Book excursions early. Eresfjord has no independent taxi rank or tour operators at the pier. If you want to leave the village, your cruise line excursion or a pre-booked private...
- Norway is cashless. You don't need Norwegian krone in hand — Visa and Mastercard are accepted for everything from a coffee at the grocery to excursion tickets.
