- Franconian Beer & Food Tasting** — Erlangen was once a major beer-exporting city.
 - Day Trip: Nuremberg** — Nuremberg is just 15–20 minutes by regional train from Erlangen Hauptbahnhof.
 - Botanical Garden & Schlossgarten** — Erlangen's university botanical garden adjoins the Schlossgarten, offering alpine plants, tropical greenhouses, and...

BEST WALKS

- Huguenot Baroque Loop** 2.5 km · ~45 min · Easy · Free — From the canal dock, follow the path east into the city.
- Old Town & Beer Garden Stroll** 3 km · ~1 hr · Easy — Cross from the Baroque Neustadt into the older Altstadt north of the Schwabach River, then swing back south to Steinbach Bräu for a...

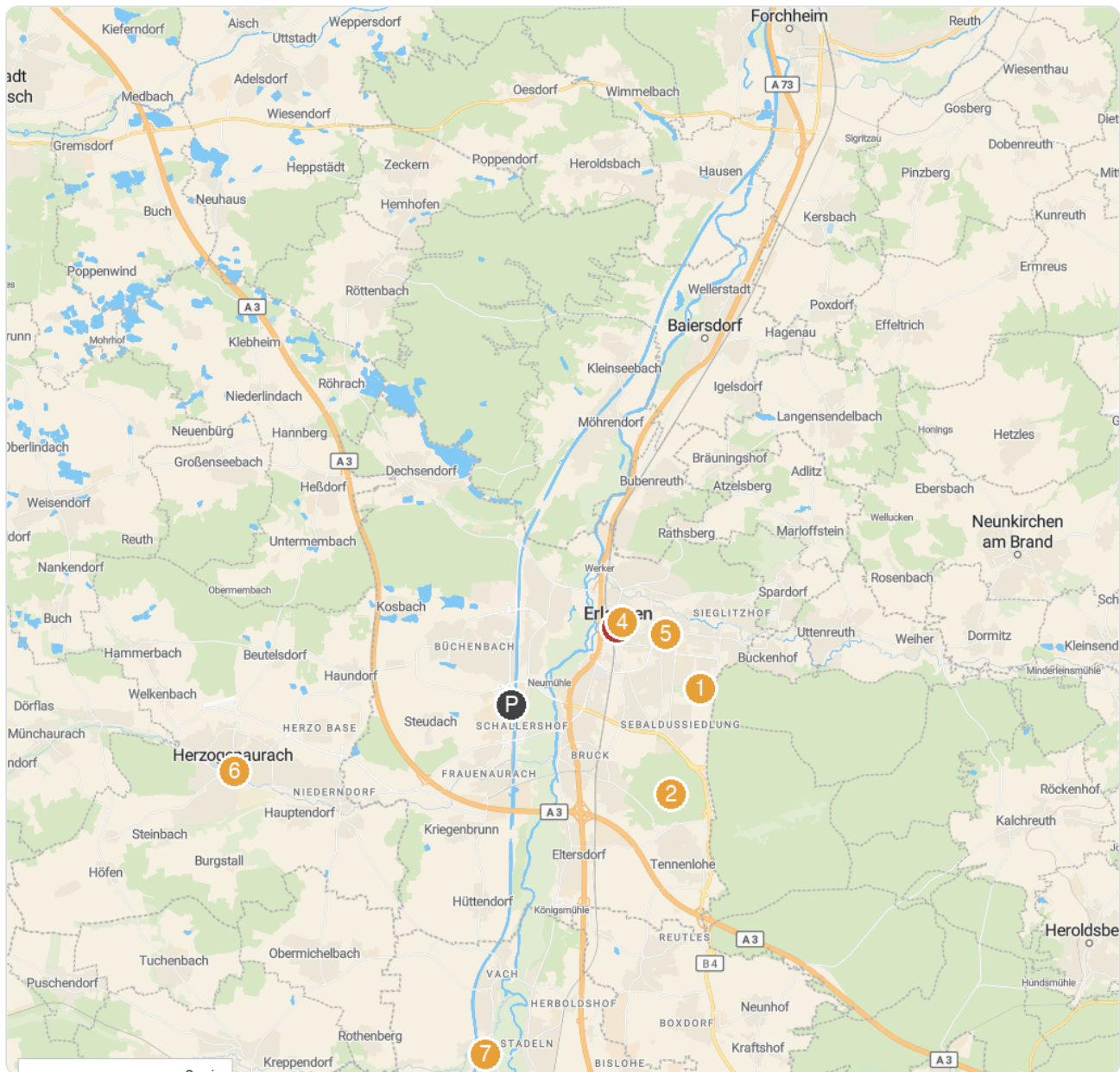
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Carry cash. Many traditional Erlangen taverns, bakeries, and beer gardens are cash-only. ATMs are plentiful near Hugenottenplatz.
- Grab a bike. Erlangen is one of Germany's most bike-friendly cities. The flat canal path from dock to center takes under 10 minutes — far faster and more enjoyable than walking.
