GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Direct alongside floating pontoon on the Corniche — no tender

Best For: Ancient temples, lock transit spectacle, authentic bazaar

Walk to Temple: ~400 m / 10 min through the souk

Don't Miss: The restored astronomical ceiling inside the Hypostyle Hall

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Temple of Khnum** — Descend 9 metres below modern street level into the only excavated part of a massive Ptolemaic–Roman temple.
- **Esna Souk (El-Qaysariya Market)** — The historic covered street market linking the riverfront to the temple is Esna's living heart.
- **Esna Lock Transit** — The Esna weir lock raises and lowers ships up to 8 metres to navigate the Nile dam.
- **Wekalet El-Gedawy Caravanserai** — A restored 18th-century caravanserai (merchants' inn) steps from the temple — one of few surviving examples in Upper...
- **Corniche Stroll & Local Life** — Walk Esna's Nile-front Corniche to watch feluccas, fishing boats, and farmers working the fertile green strip between...

BEST WALKS

- **Pier to Temple Loop** ~1 km · 20 min · flat · easy — Leave the gangway, head into the covered souk street, reach the Temple of Khnum, descend into the excavation, then return via the...

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Cards preferred at the temple. Egypt has been rolling out card-only payment at major monuments. Bring a Visa/Mastercard, but keep a few hundred EGP for the souk and street vendors.
- Dress modestly. Esna is a traditional, conservative town. Cover shoulders and knees — light linen trousers and a t-shirt are comfortable in the heat.
- The best merchants are entertainment. The rowboat vendors at the lock are part of the experience, but if you catch a throw
