TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Avenue of the Giants Drive** — A 31-mile scenic highway through old-growth redwoods south of Eureka, passing trees over 300 feet tall and 1,000 years...
 - **Redwood Sky Walk at Sequoia Park Zoo** — Walk suspension bridges over 100 feet up through the redwood canopy at Sequoia Park — California's oldest zoo (est.
- **Madaket Harbor Cruise** — Board the M.V.
 - **Blue Ox Millworks Living History Park** — A working Victorian millwork shop where craftspeople use antique machinery to create ornate gingerbread architecture.
 - **Carson Mansion & Victorian Walking Tour** — The 1886 Carson Mansion is widely regarded as the most spectacular Victorian house in America.

BEST WALKS

- **Old Town & Waterfront Loop** 1.5 miles · 45 min · Flat — From Schneider Dock, follow the waterfront boardwalk north past the F Street Pier, then cut inland along 2nd Street through the heart...
- **Carson Mansion Stroll** 1.8 miles round-trip · 45 min · Flat — Head east along 2nd or 3rd Street from Old Town to reach the Carson Mansion at M Street.

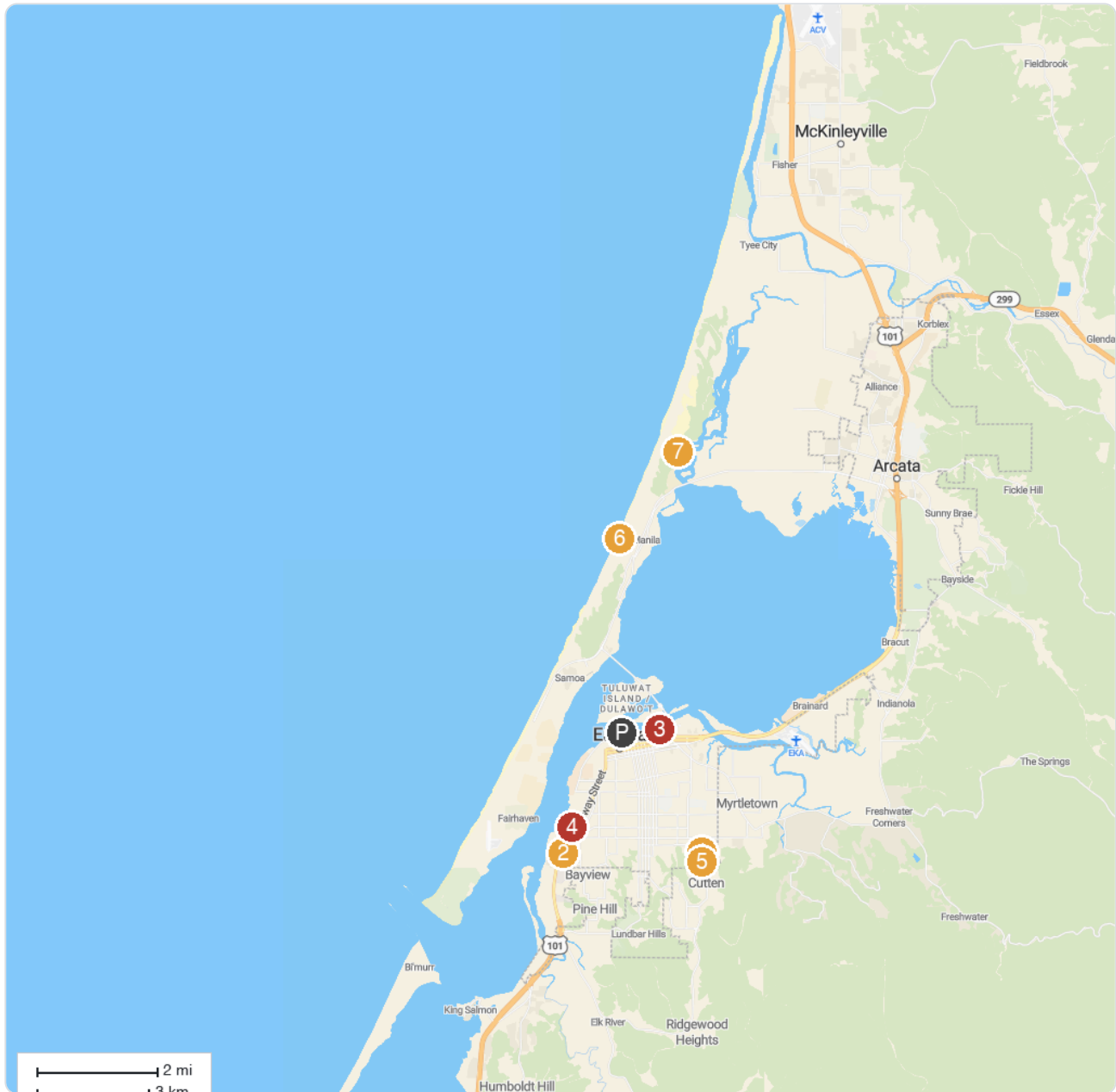
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Layer up — Eureka is foggy. The marine layer means even summer days rarely top 65°F (18°C). A windbreaker and layers are essential; morning arrivals will be cool and misty.
- Book the redwoods early. Ship-organized excursions to the Avenue of the Giants or Humboldt Redwoods State Park sell out fast — the drive alone is 45 minutes each way, so plan...
