GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier at Evansville Inland Marina (850 LST Drive) — no tendering

Best For: WWII history, Victorian architecture, Midwestern food culture

Walk to center: Marina sits ~2 mi from downtown — short rideshare or shuttle, not a casual walk

Don't Miss: USS LST-325 — last operational WWII landing ship in the US

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **USS LST-325 — WWII Landing Ship** — The last fully operational, navigable WWII Landing Ship, Tank (LST) in the United States, berthed at 610 NW Riverside...
- **Reitz Home Museum — Victorian Mansion** — One of America's finest examples of French Second Empire architecture (1871), in the downtown Riverside Historic...
- **Evansville Museum of Arts, History & Science** — Downtown riverfront museum covering Ohio River Valley history, American art, a planetarium, and a 1908 steam locomotive...
- **Haynie's Corner Arts District** — Evansville's artsy neighborhood with outdoor installations, local galleries, and a lively fountain square, just south...
- **Midwestern Food Crawl** — Chase Evansville's culinary quirks: the infamous fried brain sandwich at Hilltop Inn, a giant pork tenderloin sandwich...

BEST WALKS

- **Downtown Riverfront Loop** ~1.2 miles · ~30 min · Flat & paved — From the downtown riverfront, stop at the Pagoda for a map, walk south along Riverside Drive to the USS LST-325, then cut inland a...
- **Victorian District Walk** ~0.8 miles · ~20 min · Flat — From the downtown riverfront, head a few blocks inland into the Riverside Historic District for preserved Victorian, Queen Anne, and...

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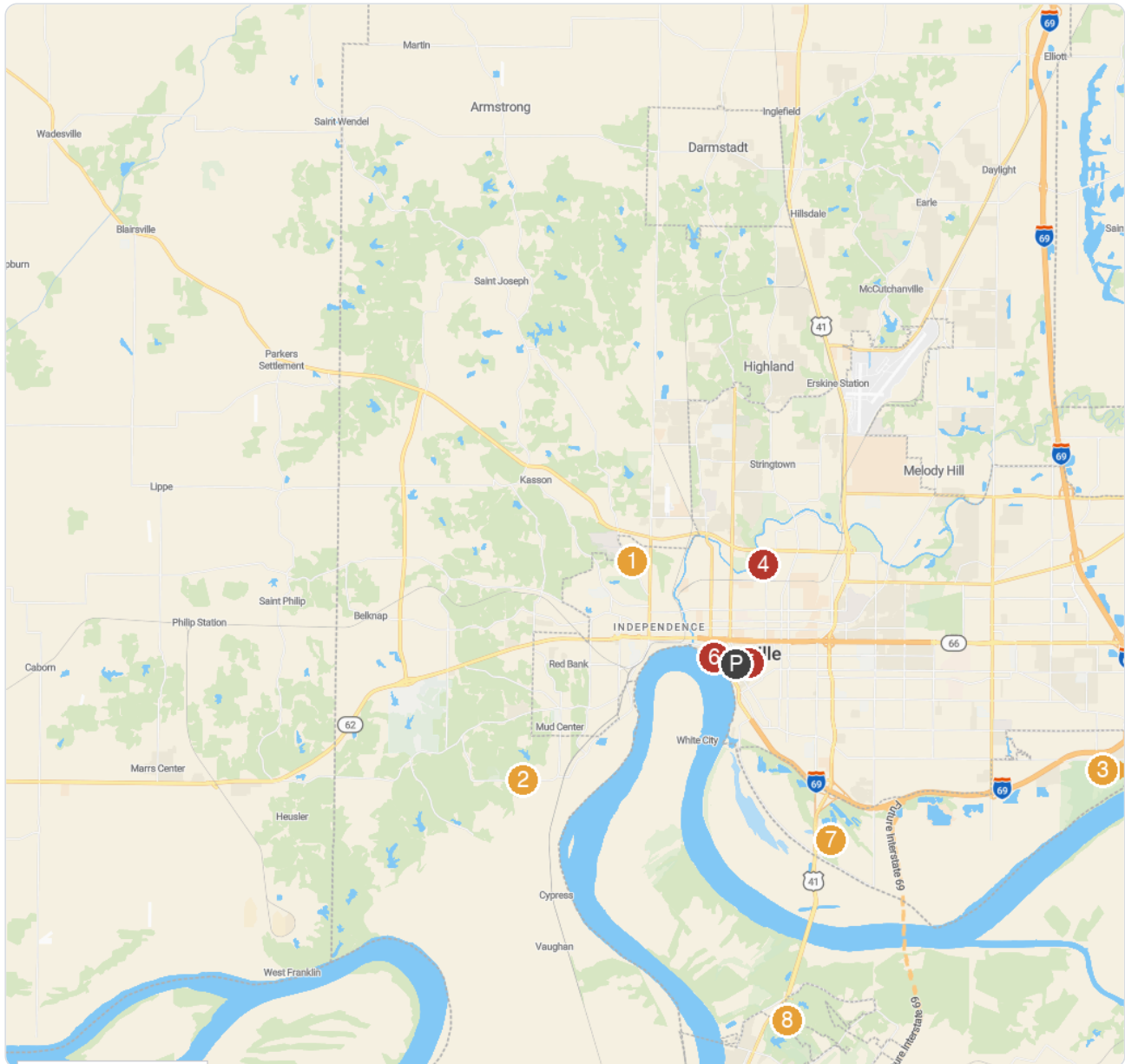
