GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Small quay — boutique/expedition ships dock directly; max draft ~4 m. Larger ships tender.

Walk to center: 2–5 min from the quay to Torvet (main square)

Best For: Scandinavian art, island-hopping, quiet cobblestone walks, smoked fish

Don't Miss: Faaborg Museum (Funen Painters) and a ferry to Lyø or Avernakø

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Faaborg Museum — Funen Painters** — One of Denmark's most important regional art museums, the 1915 building itself is a total work of art.
- **Egeskov Castle** — One of Europe's best-preserved Renaissance water castles, Egeskov sits on oak piles in a lake ~21 km from Faaborg.
- **Ferry to Lyø or Avernakø** — Short passenger ferries from Faaborg harbour reach the quiet archipelago islands of Lyø and Avernakø — car-free...
- **Svanninge Hills (Fynske Alps)** — Denmark's hilliest terrain — modest by international standards but genuinely dramatic for this flat country.
- **Cobblestone Town Walk & Øhavsmuseet** — Wander Faaborg's medieval lanes, past the old church, the freestanding medieval Bell Tower (Klokketårnet), and the...

BEST WALKS

- **Harbor to Old Town Loop** 1.5 km · 25–35 min · Easy — A short loop that takes in the harbor, main square (Torvet), the medieval church, the Bell Tower, and the Øhavsmuseet before returning...
- **To the Faaborg Museum** 0.8 km one way · 10 min · Easy — A straight walk from the harbor through the pedestrian zone to the Faaborg Museum on Grønnegade — the cultural highlight of any call...

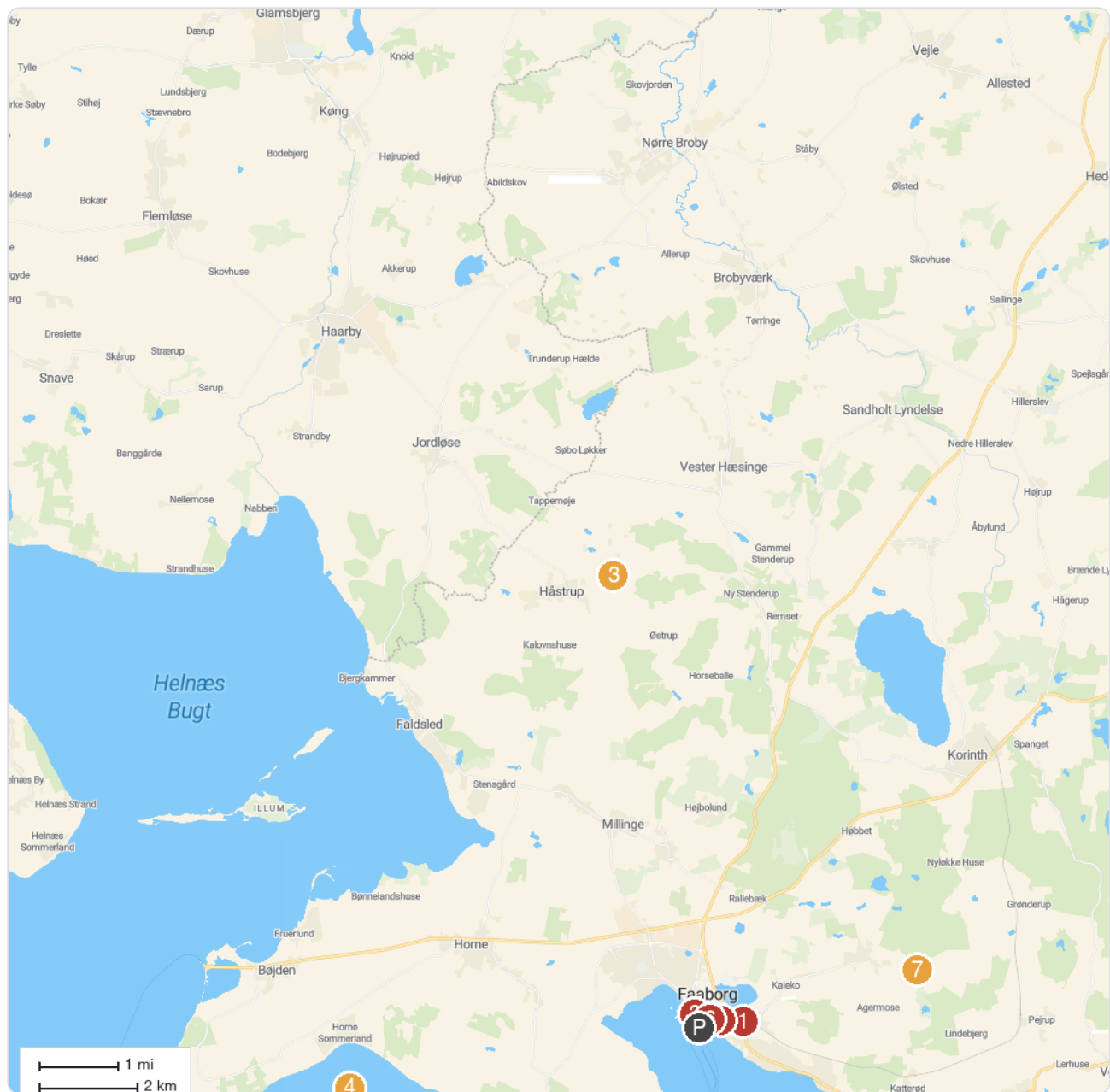
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
