- Volunteer Point King Penguin Colony** — The Falklands' most spectacular excursion: a 1,000+ breeding-pair King Penguin colony, plus Gentoo and Magellanic...
- Gypsy Cove & Magellanic Penguins** — The closest wildlife day-trip from Stanley.
- 1982 Falklands War Battlefield Tour** — Local guides — some who lived through the conflict — lead you to Mount Longdon, Mount Harriet, and the Liberation...
- Bertha's Beach & Gentoo Penguins** — A sweeping expanse of white sand near Mount Pleasant, with Gentoo penguins nesting near the surf and dolphins regularly...
- Stanley Town Walk & Historic Dockyard Museum** — Self-guided town walk taking in Christ Church Cathedral, the Whalebone Arch, the Liberation Monument, and the excellent...

BEST WALKS

- Ross Road Heritage Stroll** 1.5 miles | 30–45 min | Easy flat seafront — Walk west along Ross Road from the Public Jetty past the Whalebone Arch, Christ Church Cathedral, and the Liberation Monument, then...
- Lady Elizabeth Shipwreck Walk** 2 miles one-way | 1 hr | Easy flat — Head east along Ross Road and the shoreline path to Whalebone Cove.
