GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Small luxury and expedition ships tender into Falmouth Harbour or berth at the marina; large ships dock in St. John's instead

Best For: History, sailing culture, hilltop views, snorkeling

Walk to center: ~30-35 min walk (or short taxi) to Nelson's Dockyard and English Harbour restaurants

Don't Miss: Shirley Heights Sunday party (if your call coincides) and sunset from the Lookout

- **Nelson's Dockyard National Park** — Explore the world's only continuously operating Georgian naval dockyard — a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- **Shirley Heights Lookout** — Hike or taxi up to this former military signal station for panoramic views over Falmouth and English Harbours — on a...
- **Pigeon Point Beach & Fort Berkeley Hike** — Pigeon Point Beach sits just minutes from the pier with calm, clear water and beach bars.
- **Catamaran Snorkel Cruise** — Sail the south coast on a catamaran for snorkeling at Cades Reef — one of Antigua's best coral gardens — then enjoy a...
- **Stingray City Encounter** — Interact with friendly Southern Rays in their natural shallow-water habitat off the east coast near Seaton's Village...

BEST WALKS

- **Falmouth Harbour to Nelson's Dockyard & English Harbour** 2.5 km · 30-35 min · Easy · Paved path — Walk along the waterfront from the pier into Nelson's Dockyard, through the Copper and Lumber Store courtyard, and continue to the...
- **Dow's Hill Interpretation Centre to Shirley Heights** 1.2 km · 30 min · Moderate · Some uphill — Start at the Dow's Hill Interpretation Centre (a short taxi ride from the pier) for an animated history of Antigua, then walk the...

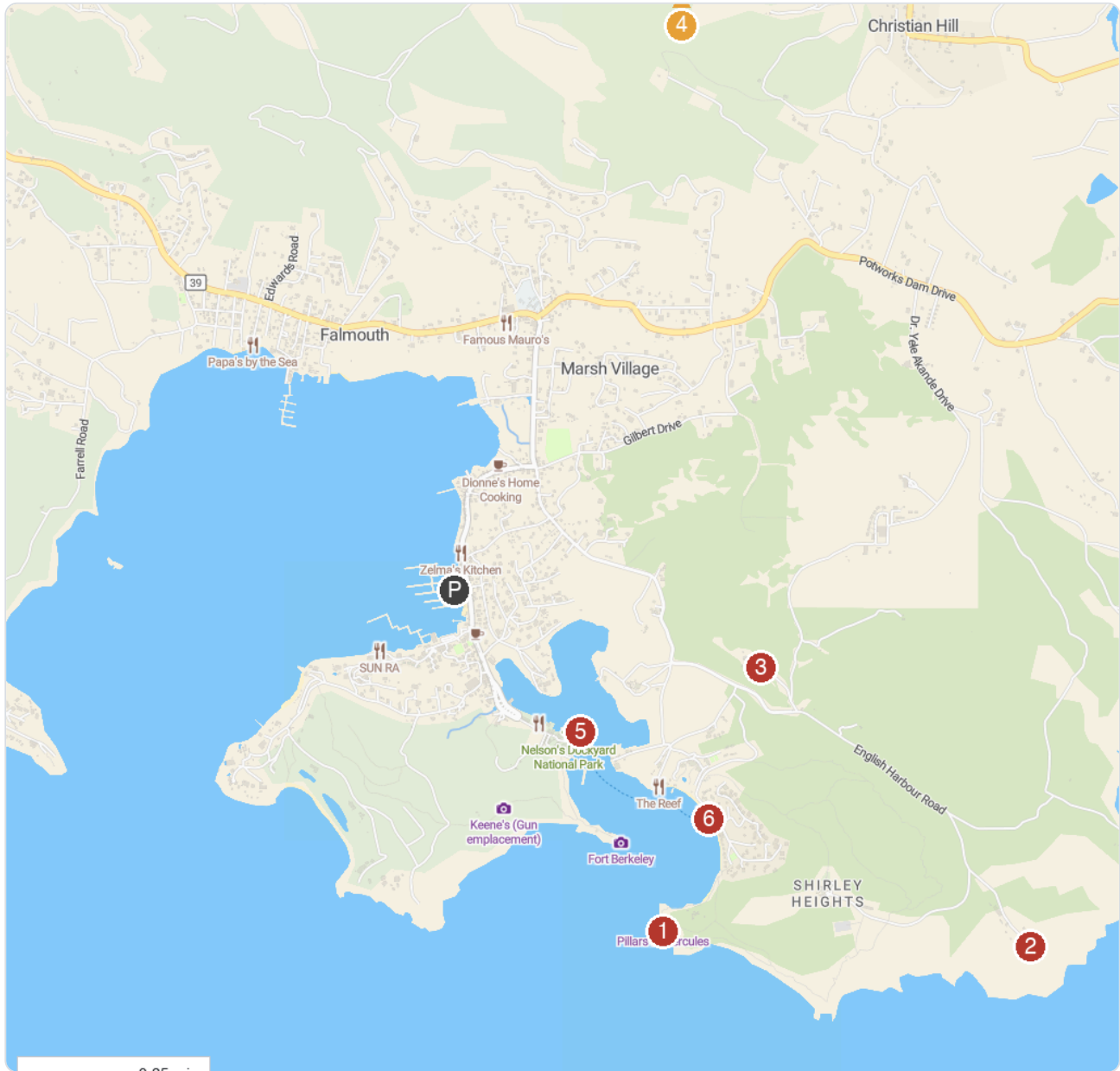
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
