GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Two deep-water berths accommodate Oasis-class ships; ships dock, not tender

Best For: History buffs, river rafters, waterfall climbers, bioluminescent bay seekers

Walk to center: 5–10 min (300–800 m) along level walkways to Falmouth's historic district

Don't Miss: Luminous Lagoon boat tour at dusk — one of the world's brightest bioluminescent bays

Getting around: **Taxi** \$15–\$60 USD

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Martha Brae River Bamboo Rafting** — Float 3 miles down the Martha Brae River on a 30-foot bamboo raft poled by a local captain.
 - **Dunn's River Falls Climb** — Jamaica's most famous attraction: 55-metre terraced waterfalls near Ocho Rios that you climb in a human chain.
 - **Luminous Lagoon Night Boat Tour** — Glistening Waters Luminous Lagoon, just 10 minutes from the pier, is among
- the world's brightest bioluminescent bays.

 - **Falmouth Georgian Town Walk** — Falmouth's historic district is one of the best-preserved colonial Georgian towns in the Caribbean.
 - **Chukka Good Hope Estate Eco Adventures** — Former 18th-century sugar plantation 25 minutes from the pier now hosts zip-lining, ATV rides, river tubing, and a...

BEST WALKS

- **Falmouth Historic District Loop** 1.5 km · 30–45 min · Flat — Walk from the pier into Water Square, the civic heart of old Falmouth.

- USD is king. US dollars are accepted everywhere tourists go; no need to change money. Keep small bills for tips, taxis, and market purchases.
- Fix your taxi fare first. Official JUTA taxis queue at the port with regulated rates — always agree on the price before you get in. No Uber in Falmouth.
