GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Small ships dock at Falmouth Town Marina or nearby marinas; no dedicated large cruise terminal

Best For: Martha's Vineyard day trips, cycling the Shining Sea Bikeway, seafood

Walk to center: ~5 min from marina to Main Street

Don't Miss: Nobska Lighthouse views and the Island Queen ferry to Martha's Vineyard from Falmouth Harbor

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Martha's Vineyard Day Trip** — Hop the ~35-minute Island Queen ferry from Falmouth Harbor to Oak Bluffs on Martha's Vineyard.
- Shining Sea Bikeway** — Pedal this beloved 10.7-mile paved rail trail from North Falmouth to Woods Hole past salt marshes, cranberry bogs, and...
- Nobska Lighthouse & Woods Hole Village** — Walk or cab to the 1876 Nobska Light for sweeping views across Vineyard Sound to Martha's Vineyard.
- Old Silver Beach** — One of Cape Cod's finest beaches — white sand, calm warm waters, and tide pools on the Buzzards Bay shore.
- Falmouth Museums on the Green & Historic Highfield Hall** — Visit the Falmouth Museums on the Green for colonial-era history and maritime heritage, then head to the restored 1878...

BEST WALKS

- Main Street to Village Green Stroll** 1 mile · 30 min · Easy — From the marina, walk Main Street past independent shops, bakeries, and the historic Falmouth Village Green.
- Nobska Lighthouse Walk (Woods Hole)** 1.5 miles round-trip · 45 min · Easy — From Woods Hole Ferry Terminal, walk Church Street and Nobska Road out to Nobska Light.

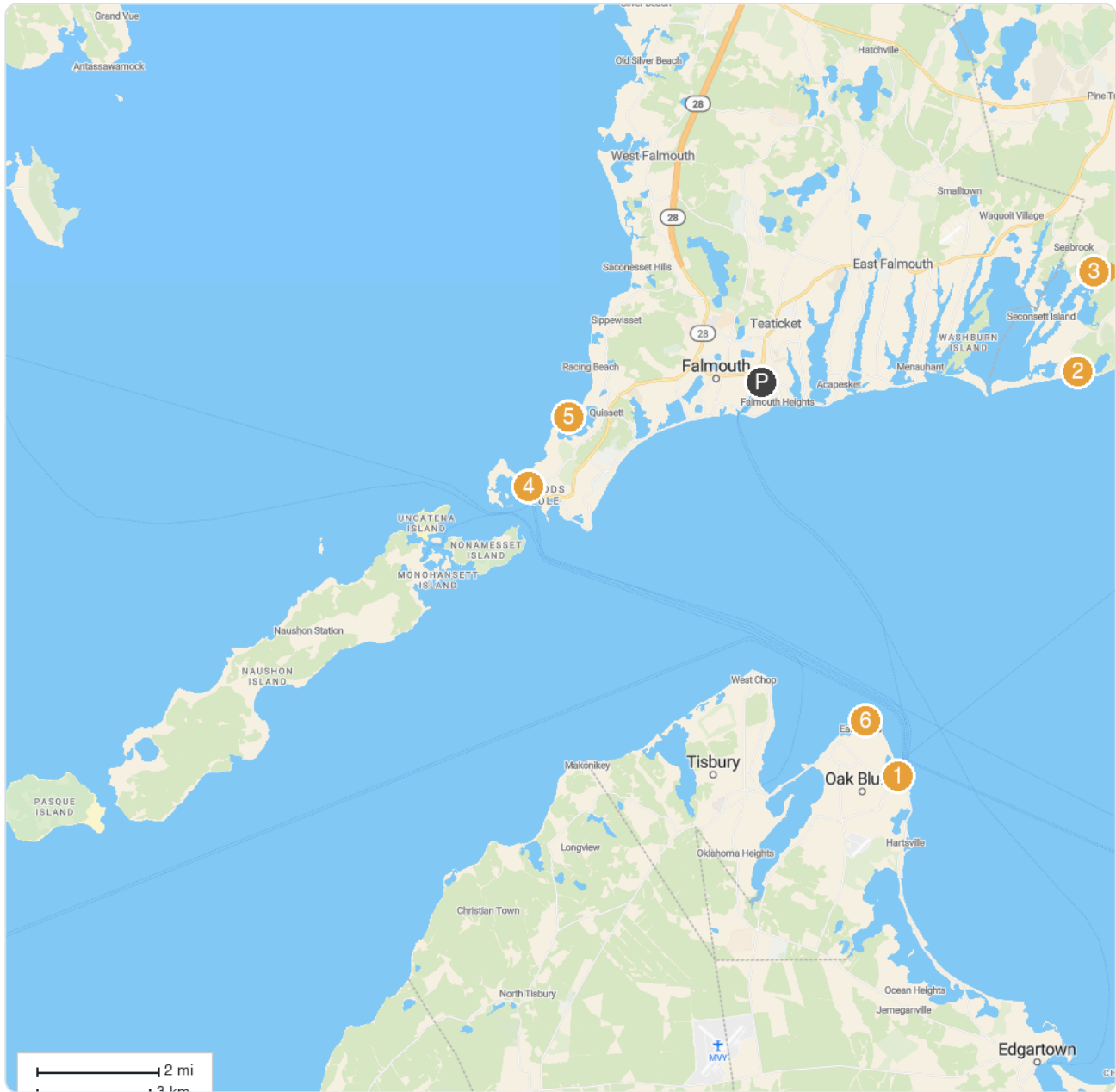
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
