GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Falmouth Cruise Ship Pier — purpose-built (2011), can berth two Oasis-class ships simultaneously

Best For: Georgian architecture, Martha Brae river rafting, Dunn's River Falls day trip, Chukka Blue Hole

Walk to center: ~5 min walk from pier gate to Falmouth's historic town square and courthouse

Don't Miss: Falmouth Courthouse (1815) and Water Square — the original piped-water fountain predating New York City's

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  ~\$5–10 USD (local); ~\$45–60 USD to Montego Bay

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Martha Brae River Rafting** — Just 5 km from the pier, bamboo raft operators pole you along a calm, jungle-lined river on a two-seat bamboo raft.
- **Chukka Blue Hole & River Tubing** — Chukka's Blue Hole excursion takes you into the Trelawny interior to swim in crystalline limestone pools, tube down a...
- **Dunn's River Falls** — Jamaica's most iconic landmark sits ~65 km east near Ocho Rios.
- **Falmouth Heritage Walk** — Falmouth is one of the best-preserved Georgian towns in the Caribbean, with over 50 listed heritage buildings from the...
- **Good Hope Great House & Estate Tour** — A 2,000-acre 18th-century plantation in the Trelawny hills, Good Hope offers horse riding, ATV tours, and river...

BEST WALKS

- **Falmouth Georgian Heritage Loop** 1.5-2 hrs · ~2.5 km · Easy · Flat — A self-guided loop through the core of Falmouth's UNESCO-listed historic district.
- **Pier to Town Stroll** 30 min · ~1 km · Easy — A simple orientation walk from the cruise pier into the town centre.
- **Georgian Falmouth Town Walk** 1.5 km | ~1 hr | Easy | Free — Start at the cruise terminal gate and follow Harbour Street west to Water Square.
