GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — deepwater quay, ~10-min walk to Torvet (town square)

Best For: Beaches, cycling the Lista peninsula, WWII history, quiet charm

Walk to center: 10 min from main pier; smaller ships dock right at town quay

Don't Miss: Lista Fyr lighthouse & the American enclave of Vanse village

Getting around: **Taxi** 200–265 NOK (~\$18–25 USD) · **Rideshare** not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Lista Lighthouse Climb** — The 34-metre stone lighthouse at Lista Fyr has guided ships since 1836.
 - Nordberg Fort (WWII Coastal Artillery)** — One of Norway's best-preserved German coastal fortifications from WWII.
 - Vanse & 'Little America'** — Eight kilometres from port, the village of Vanse has a unique link to Brooklyn — early-to-mid 20th-century emigrants...
- Lista Beach Day** — The Lista peninsula holds some of Southern Norway's finest sandy beaches.
 - Loshavn Village Walk** — A beautifully preserved old port village ~4 km south of Farsund, with 18th-century wooden houses among the...

BEST WALKS

- Harbour & White-House Town Walk** 1.5 km · 30 min · Easy — From the pier, stroll along Bryggeslengen (the waterfront promenade) into Torvet (town square).
- Gervoll Woods & Suspension Bridge** 3 km · 45 min · Easy — A 20-minute walk from the pier leads to Gervollskogen, a peaceful park with forest paths, a small suspension bridge, and lakeside...

- Go cashless. Norway is card-only — Visa and Mastercard work in every café, bus, and tourist shop. You won't need Krone in your pocket.
