TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Historic Harbour & Rum Museum** — Wander among classic wooden sailing ships and the 1908 steamship Alexandra at the Historischer Hafen, then duck into...
- **Rote Straße Merchant Courtyards** — Duck into the hidden Kaufmannshöfe (merchants' courtyards) off Rote Straße — colourful 17th-century trading courtyards...
- **Fischbrötchen & Local Food Trail** — Join the inevitable queue at Ben's Fischhütte at the Historic Harbour for a freshly made fish bun — herring or salmon...
- **Solitude Beach** — A sandy fjord beach on the eastern shore with a pier, playground, and an Italian restaurant with views across to Denmark.
- **Museumsberg Flensburg** — A hilltop museum complex overlooking the fjord, covering regional art and cultural history from the German-Danish...

BEST WALKS

- **Harbour to Old Town Loop** 3–4 km · 1.5–2 hrs · Easy, flat — Start at the Historic Harbour among the classic sailing ships, walk south along the waterfront to Schiffbrücke, then cut inland up...
- **Waterfront Promenade to Ostseebad Beach** 4–5 km one way · 45–60 min · Easy, flat — Follow the fjord promenade north from the harbour to the Ostseebad historic bathing area on the western shore, with its wooden pier...

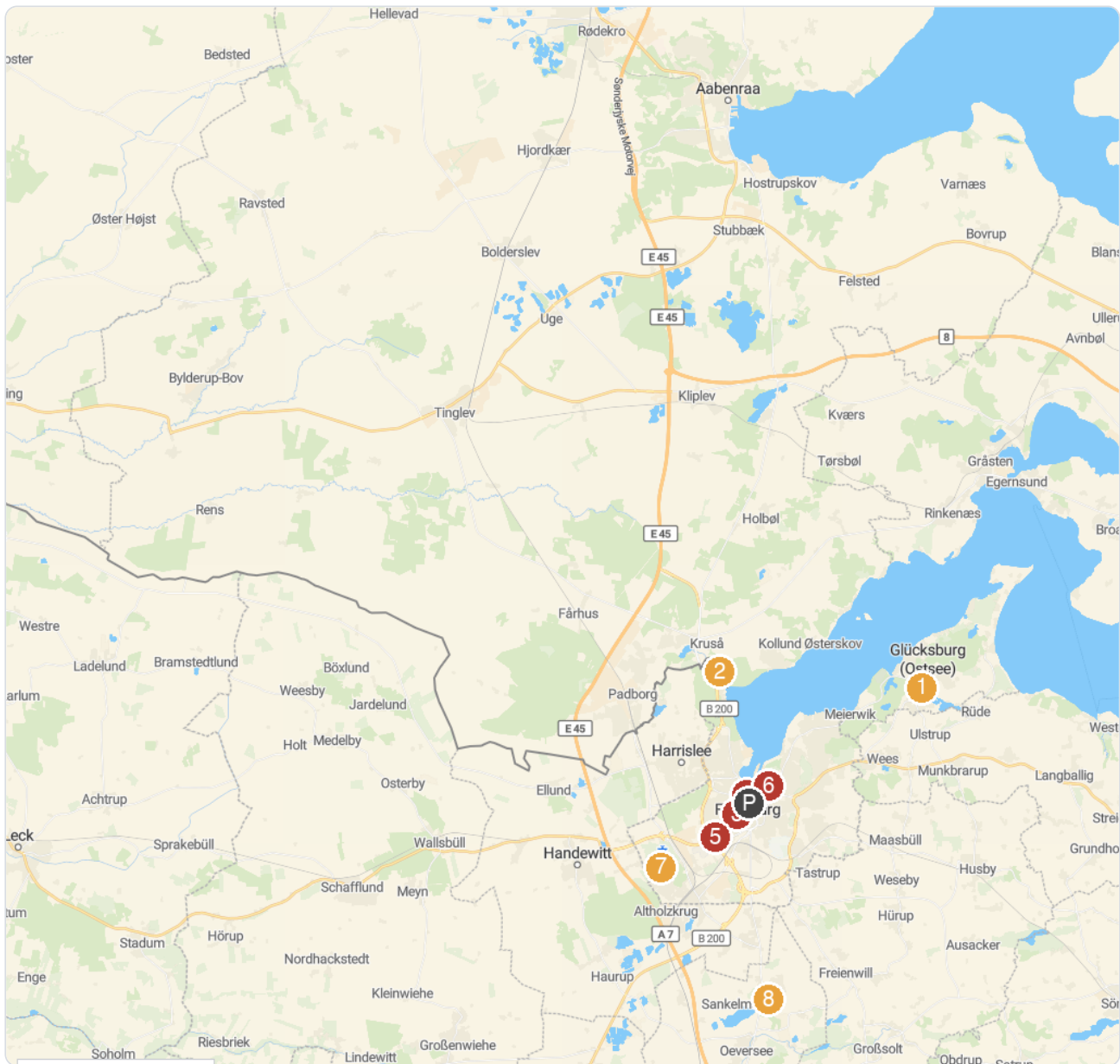
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
