GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — Lajes das Flores pier has been storm-damaged since 2019 (Hurricane Lorenzo); a major new-port reconstruction is underway, projected to complete around 2030

Best For: Nature lovers, hikers, photographers, and anyone who wants the unplugged Azores experience

Walk to center: 10–15 min uphill from tender dock into Lajes das Flores village

Don't Miss: Poço Ribeira do Ferreiro — a waterfall amphitheater that belongs in a nature documentary

Getting around: Taxi €23–€29 · Rideshare not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Poço Ribeira do Ferreiro & Waterfall Circuit** — Flores's signature sight: a dramatic green amphitheater where a dozen waterfalls plunge into a serene lagoon.
 - Crater Lakes — Lagoa Negra & Lagoa Comprida** — Twin volcanic calderas filled with inky blue-green water, sitting side by side in the center of the island.
 - Canyoning on Flores** — Flores is considered one of Europe's top canyoning destinations — deep gorges, multi-
- drop waterfalls, and natural...

 - Fajã Grande & West Coast Drive** — The westernmost village in Europe, tucked beneath massive cliff faces draped in waterfalls.
 - RIB Boat to Corvo Island** — Tiny Corvo — the smallest island in the Azores — is visible from Flores and reachable in about 45 minutes by rigid...

BEST WALKS

- Lajes das Flores Village & Natural Pools** 1–2 hrs · Easy · No transport needed — From the tender dock, walk uphill into Lajes das Flores: explore the small church, local cafes, and the fishing harbor.

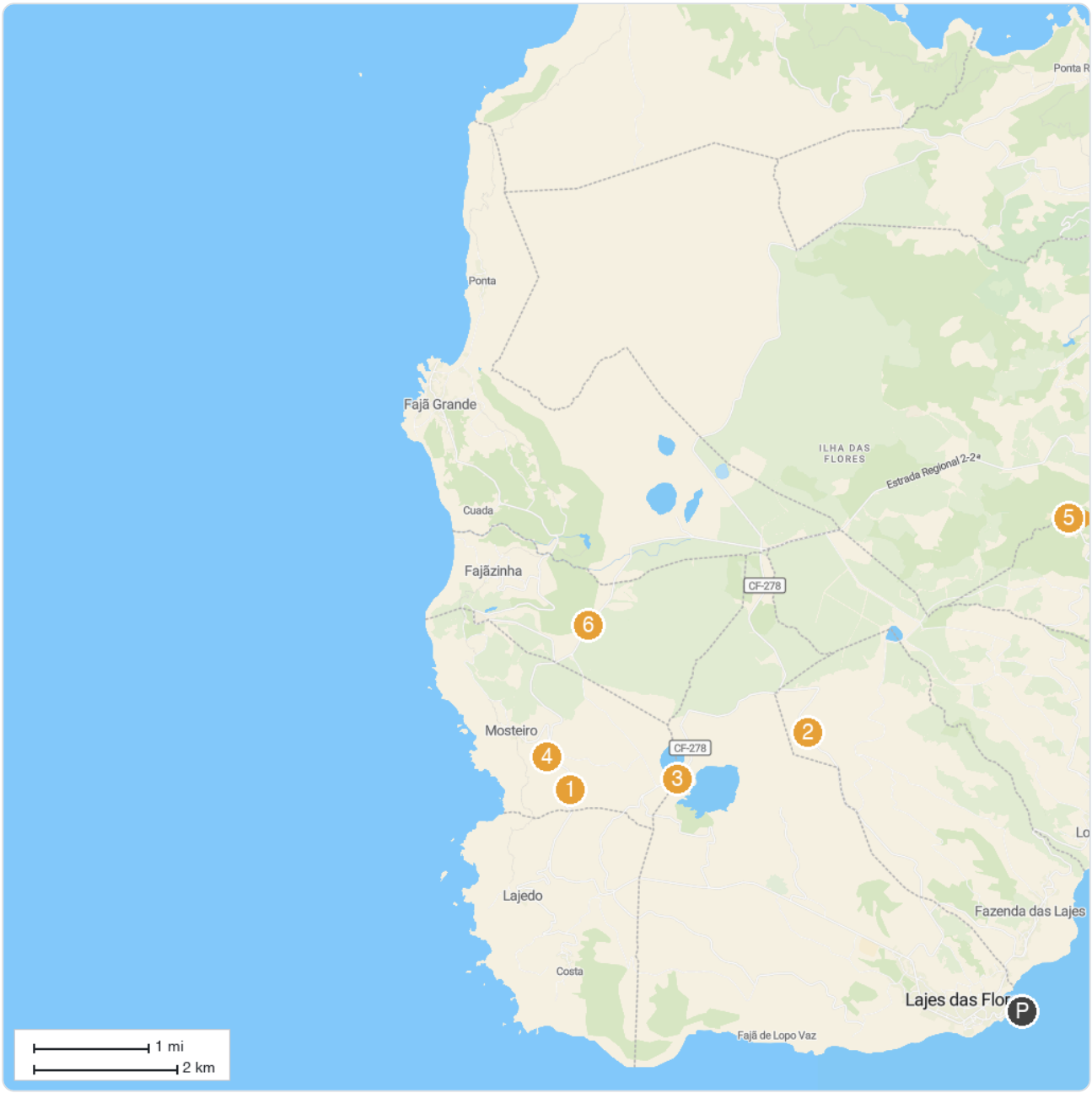
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Pre-book everything. Flores has roughly 3,500 residents and almost no tourist infrastructure. If you don't arrange a tour or rental car before your cruise, you will be stuck in...
- Cancellations are common. Atlantic swells regularly make tendering unsafe. Flores has one of the highest cancellation rates in the Azores — always have a B-plan and don't
