GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — ships anchor in Loch Linnhe; boats land at the Fort William Pontoons (West End Car Park; installed 2016, extended 2022 & 2023)

Best For: Scenery, Jacobite train fans, whisky lovers, hikers, Harry Potter itineraries

Walk to center: 1-2 min from tender pontoon to High Street (flat, paved)

Don't Miss: Jacobite Steam Train (book months ahead) or watch it cross Glenfinnan Viaduct from below

Getting around: **Taxi** £5–£10 (short trips)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Jacobite Steam Train to Mallaig** — Board the "Hogwarts Express" at Fort William station for a 42-mile journey through the Highlands, crossing the...
 - Nevis Range Mountain Gondola** — The UK's only mountain gondola carries you 650m up Aonach Mòr for panoramic views of the Great Glen and Ben Nevis.
 - Glencoe Highland Excursion** — Drive 30 minutes south to Scotland's most dramatic glen — volcanic peaks, sweeping
- moorland, and the site of the 1692...

 - Ben Nevis Distillery Tour & Tasting** — Founded in 1825 at the foot of Ben Nevis, this working single-malt distillery offers guided tours and drams of its...
 - Glenfinnan Viaduct Viewpoint (DIY)** — If you can't get Jacobite tickets, take the coach or hire a taxi to the Glenfinnan Monument & Viaduct viewpoint.

BEST WALKS

- High Street & Town Centre Stroll** 0.5 miles · 20-30 min · Flat — From the pontoons, walk up to the High Street for the West Highland Museum (free; Jacobite relics), the "Sore Feet"...
- Old Inverlochy Castle Walk** 2.4 miles round-trip · 50-60 min · Flat/easy — Head north from the town center along the River Lochy to the ruins of a 13th-century castle — uncommercialized, free, and very...
