- **Beach Buggy Adventure to Cumbuco Beach** — Take a high-speed buggy ride through the white sand dunes of Cumbuco Beach, stopping at lagoons for a refreshing dip...
- **City Center & Dragão do Mar Center of Art and Culture** — Explore the Dragão do Mar Center of Art and Culture, a hub for museums, galleries, and theaters, and visit the nearby...

- **Mucuripe Fish Market Walk Port Area** — A short walk from the ship to the Mercado do Peixe, where you can see local fishermen bringing in the fresh catch of the day and enjoy...

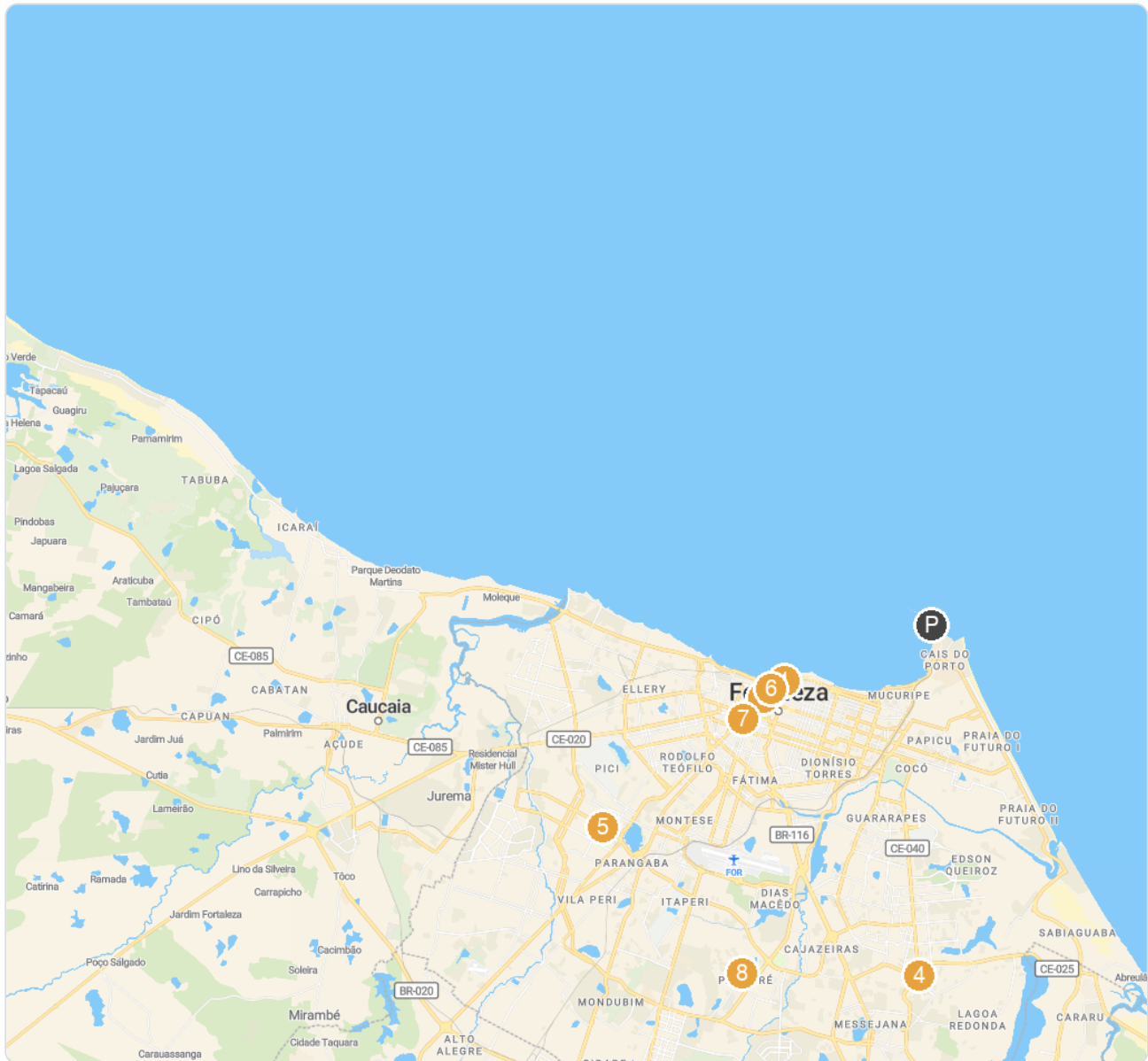
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
