GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender to Town Quay or Albert Quay — you land in the town centre

Best For: History, walking, Cornish food, literary sites, scenic estuary

Walk to centre: 0 min — tender drops right at the quay

Don't Miss: St Catherine's Castle (free), Readymoney Cove, Cornish cream tea

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **St Catherine's Castle & Readymoney Cove** — Walk the Esplanade south from the quay to reach sheltered Readymoney Cove beach, then climb the wooded trail to Henry...
 - **The Hall Walk — Circular Estuary Hike** — A legendary 4-mile circuit: take the Bodinnick car ferry across the estuary, follow wooded clifftop paths with sweeping...
- **Daphne du Maurier Literary Trail** — Fowey inspired Rebecca, Jamaica Inn, and The Birds.
 - **Eden Project** — Just 15 minutes by road, the Eden Project houses the world's largest indoor rainforest under giant biomes — a...
 - **Lost Gardens of Heligan** — Around 20-25 minutes by road, these beautifully restored Victorian gardens cover 200 acres of heritage planting, jungle...

BEST WALKS

- **Town Centre & Fore Street Wander** Easy · 30-45 min · Flat to gentle — From Town Quay, head up Fore Street through Fowey's medieval merchant quarter — independent boutiques, art galleries, traditional...
- **Esplanade to Readymoney Cove & St Catherine's Castle** Moderate · 1.5-2 hrs · Some steep sections — Head south along the Esplanade past grand Victorian houses to sheltered Readymoney Cove.

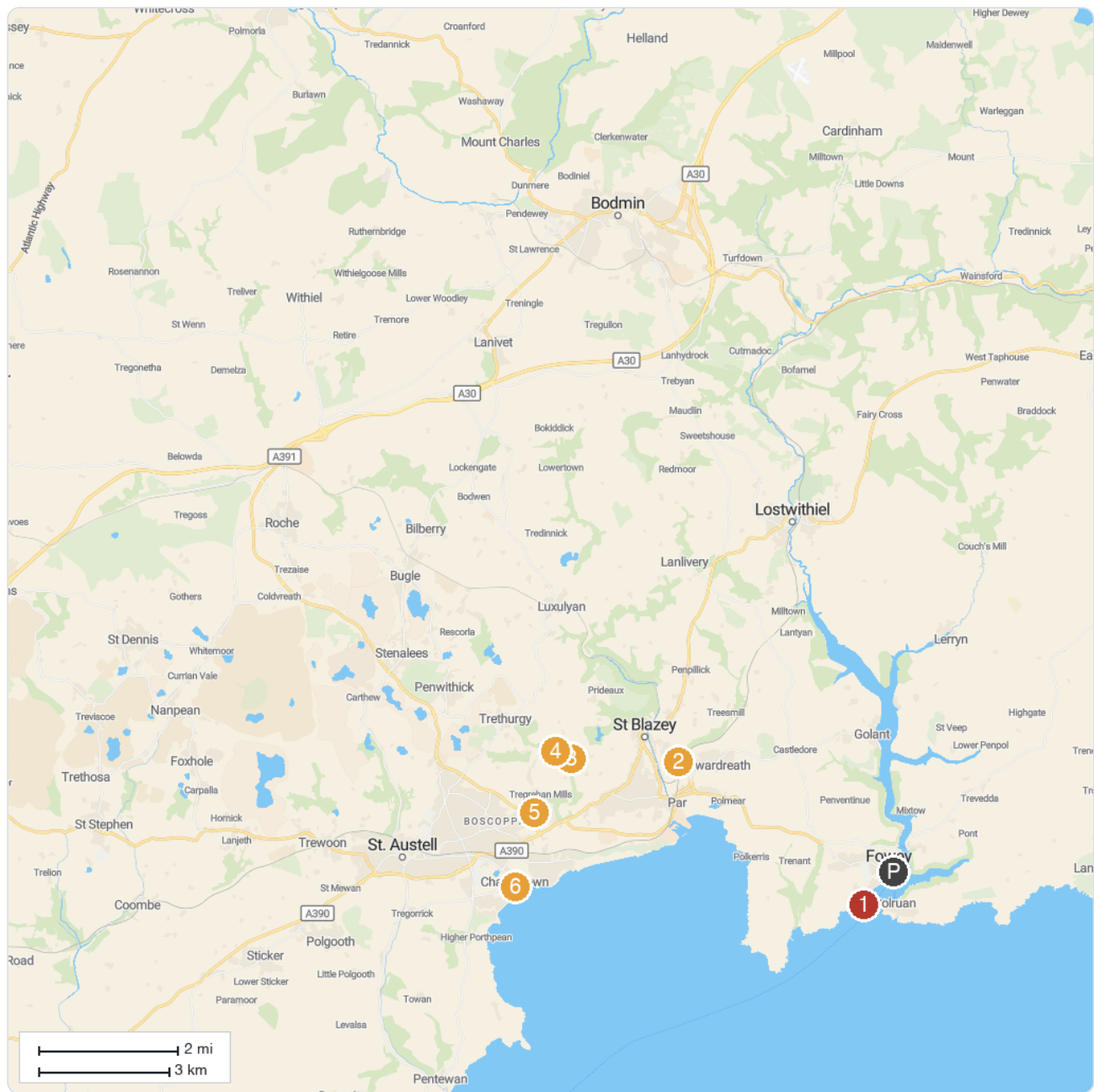
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Try a Cornish pasty. Fowey's bakeries sell the real thing — beef, potato, swede, and onion in a thick crimped pastry. Hold it by the
