TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Foynes Flying Boat & Maritime Museum** — The must-do in Foynes.
- **Adare Village Day Trip** — Often called Ireland's prettiest village, Adare (25 min by taxi) offers thatched-roof cottages, a 13th-century...
- **King John's Castle, Limerick City** — A 13th-century Norman castle on the River Shannon in Limerick City (35 min).
- **Bunratty Castle & Folk Park** — A beautifully restored 15th-century tower house paired with a living-history 19th-century Irish village.
- **Monument Hill Walk & Spring-Rice Monument** — A free, short climb from Marine Cove in the village up to the Spring-Rice Monument — a Celtic cross erected c.

BEST WALKS

- **Foynes Village Stroll** 0.5 km · 15 min · Easy — From the shuttle drop, walk to the Flying Boat Museum, continue along Main Street past O'Connor's Bar and local shops, and loop back.
- **Monument Hill Walk** 0.5 km · 30–45 min · Easy–Moderate — From Marine Cove in the village center, follow the short Monument Hill path as it climbs steeply to the Spring-Rice Monument, a Celtic...
