GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River pier on Oderpromenade, 5 min walk to Old Town

Best For: History, twin-city novelty, Gothic architecture

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **St. Mary's Church & Brick Gothic Old Town** — Frankfurt's landmark is a massive 5-aisled Gothic brick church damaged in WWII and painstakingly restored.
- **Twin-City Walk: Frankfurt → Słubice** — Cross the Stadtbrücke into Poland — no border formalities — and experience an entirely different culture in minutes.
- **Kleist Museum** — Compact museum dedicated to Heinrich von Kleist, the great German dramatist born here in 1777.
- **Lennépark Stroll** — Germany's second-oldest civic park, designed by Peter Joseph Lenné.

BEST WALKS

- **Old Town & St. Mary's Loop** 1.5 km · 25 min · flat — From the pier walk along the Oderpromenade to the Stadtbrücke, then turn inland up Collegienstraße to St.
- **Cross the Border — Słubice Walk** 2.5 km round trip · 30 min walking + time in Poland · flat — Walk from the pier to the Stadtbrücke, cross into Słubice, find the Wikipedia Monument on Plac Frankfurcki, then continue to the...

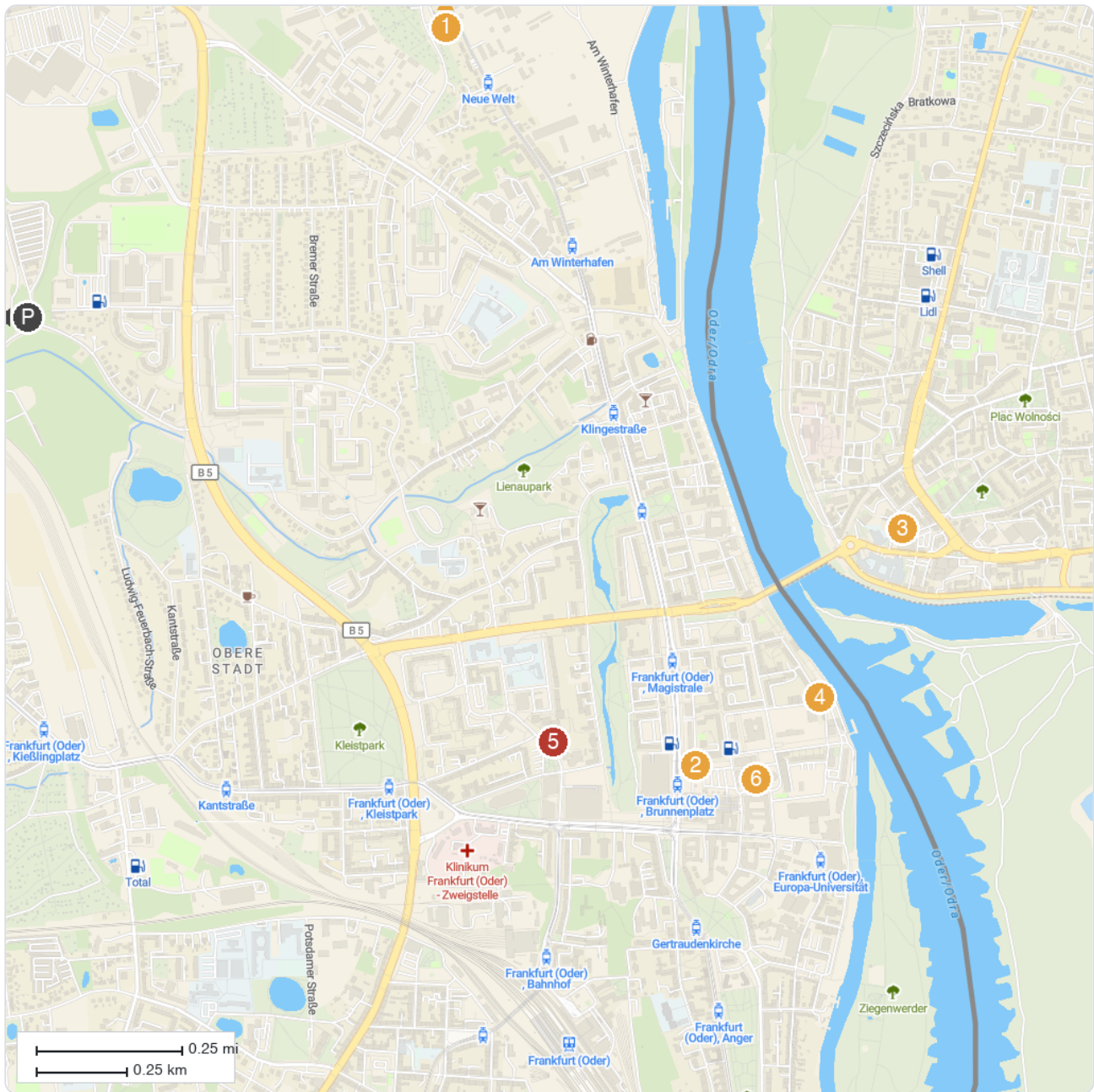
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Two currencies, one shore day. Germany uses Euros; Poland uses Polish Złoty (PLN). Most Słubice restaurants accept cards, and some take Euros — but the rate is poor. Grab a few...
- Carry ID across the border. The bridge to Poland is open (Schengen), but border police do conduct spot checks. Bring your passport or EU ID card.
- Sunday shopping laws differ. German shops in Frankfurt (Oder) are closed Sundays. Cross to Słubice — Polish Sunday shopping rules are more relaxed, and the riverside market area...
