Founded in 1650 as a royal fortress, Fredericia surprises with pristine ramparts, a Blue Flag beach minutes from the pier, and one of Denmark's most walkable town grids — all right off the ship.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — Kastelshavnen, steps from old town

Walk to center: 5–10 min (500 m to Gothersgade)

- **Ramparts Walk & Landsoldaten** — Stroll the massive star-shaped earthworks — some of the best-preserved Renaissance fortifications in Northern Europe.
- **Bridgewalking Lillebælt** — Walk across the top of the old Little Belt Bridge 60 metres above the water between Fredericia and Middelfart — one of...
- **Train to Odense — Hans Christian Andersen City** — Hop the regional train for 30 minutes to reach Odense, birthplace of Hans Christian Andersen.
- **Østerstrand Beach** — A Blue Flag beach 15 minutes' walk from the pier — white sand, shallow calm water, sea kayaks, beach volleyball, and a...
- **Fredericia Town Museum** — Explore Fredericia's multicultural founding — Huguenot and Jewish refugees, Danish military history, and the unique...

BEST WALKS

- **Ramparts & Old Town Loop** 3 km · 45–60 min · Easy — From the pier, walk along the waterfront to the Prinsens Port gate, climb the grass ramparts, follow the top of the earthworks to the...
- **Pier to Østerstrand Beach** 1.2 km · 15 min · Easy — Head south along the waterfront from the pier past the Kastellet ruins to reach Østerstrand beach.

- Go fully cashless. Denmark is one of the most cashless countries on earth — every café, taxi, bakery, and market stall takes Visa/Mastercard. No need to find an ATM.
- Check your ship's all-aboard time before heading to Odense or Aarhus. Regional trains run every 30 min, but factor in the walk to
