GETTING ASHORE

- Docking:** Ships dock at the Pontinha cruise pier (Port of Funchal), which can berth several large ships at once — a 15-20 min walk to the Old Town.
- Best For:** Gardens, levada walks, wine tasting, the Monte toboggan, and relaxed Atlantic island atmosphere.
- Walk to Center:** 15-20 min stroll east along the waterfront promenade to the Old Town (Zona Velha) and Mercado dos Lavradores.
- Don't Miss:** Cable car up to Monte, then the famous wicker-basket toboggan ride back down — a Funchal rite of passage.

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Monte Cable Car & Wicker Toboggan** — Ride the Teleférico do Funchal gondola from the Old Town up to Monte, visit the Church of Our Lady of Monte, then...
- Levada Walk — Rabaçal & 25 Fountains** — Madeira's levadas (irrigation channels) thread through ancient laurisilva forest.
- Mercado dos Lavradores & Old Town Walk** — Funchal's covered farmers' market bursts with tropical fruits, flowers, and Madeiran specialties.
- Quinta das Cruzes & Monte Palace Gardens** — The Monte Palace Tropical Garden houses a remarkable collection of azulejo tile panels, koi ponds, and exotic plants...
- Madeira Wine Lodge Tasting** — Madeira wine is one of the world's most distinctive fortified wines — and it's made right here.

BEST WALKS

- Waterfront Promenade to Zona Velha** 2.5 km · Flat · 30-40 min · Easy — Head east from the Pontinha terminal along Avenida do Mar past the marina, the city gardens, and the seafront cafés.
- Old Town to Cathedral & Wine Lodges** 1.5 km · Mostly flat · 20-30 min · Easy — From the Mercado dos Lavradores, walk west along Rua do Aljube to the Sé Cathedral (Funchal's 15th-century Gothic cathedral), then...
