TOP THINGS TO DO

- Santuario della Montagna Spaccata** — Gaeta's defining sight: a limestone cliff split in three — according to tradition, at the moment of Christ's death.
- Grotta del Turco (Turk's Cave)** — Adjacent to the Split Mountain, ~300 steps descend into a dramatic sea cave where waves surge through rocky chambers.
- Castello Angioino-Aragonese** — The great fortress dominating Gaeta's skyline has served as royal residence, military stronghold, and prison since the...
- Serapo Beach** — Gaeta's main town beach — wide golden sand, crystal-clear Blue Flag water, beach clubs with sun loungers (~€15-25) and...
- Via Indipendenza & Tiella Tasting** — Gaeta's main pedestrian street is lined with bakeries selling tiella — the town's signature double-crust savory pie...

BEST WALKS

- Old Town & Cathedral Loop** 1.5 km · 45 min · Easy (some cobblestones) — From Molo Caboto, wander through Gaeta Vecchia's narrow vicoli to the Duomo di Sant'Erasmo with its 57m Norman-Moorish campanile built...
- Port to Split Mountain** 2.5 km · 30-40 min · Moderate (uphill second half) — Follow the waterfront promenade then climb through residential streets to the Santuario della Montagna Spaccata.
- Cross-Peninsula Beach Walk** 2 km · 25 min · Easy (flat) — Cut across the narrow peninsula from the historic harbor to Serapo Beach on the other side.

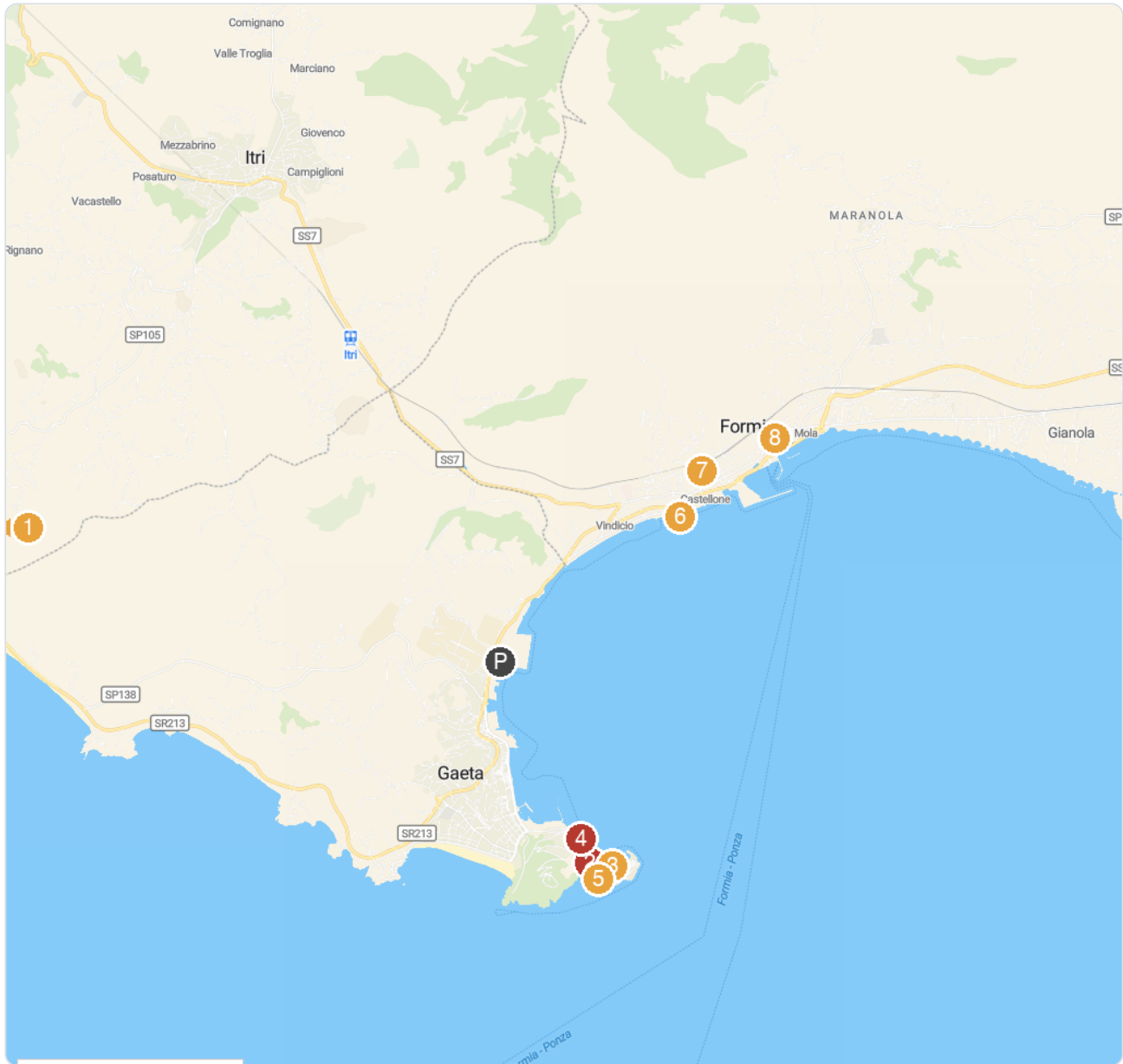
