At the end of the navigable maritime Danube, Galați blends industrial grit with a leafy promenade, Soviet-era iron sculptures, and freshly caught river fish — a surprisingly authentic slice of eastern Romania.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — ships dock at the Danube passenger terminal on the promenade; no tender needed

Best For: Danube fish dining, promenade walks, Socialist-era art, Romanian history

Walk to centre: 0 min to promenade; 10-15 min to historic Domnească Street (uphill)

Don't Miss: Scrumbie de Dunăre (Danube shad) with mămăligă and a cold local beer on the Faleza

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Faleza Dunării Promenade & Iron Sculpture Trail** — Stroll the nearly 4 km riverfront promenade and discover dozens of massive abstract iron sculptures created by Romanian...
- Precista Fortified Church & Historic Centre** — Visit the oldest surviving building in Galați (1647) — a church that doubled as a fortress against Ottoman raids — then...
- Danube Fish Lunch on the Faleza** — Galați is one of the best places in Romania to eat fresh river fish.
- Danube Ferry Crossing Micro-Adventure** — For under \$1, take the local car ferry across the Danube to I.C.
- Danube Delta Day Trip** — Galați is the gateway to the Danube Delta UNESCO Biosphere Reserve.

BEST WALKS

- Faleza Promenade & Sculpture Walk** 2.5 km · 30-45 min · Flat · Free — From the pier, walk south along the lower Faleza Dunării promenade, pausing at the iron sculptures and the 1647 Precista Fortified...
- Upper Town Historic Walk** 1.5 km · 20-30 min · Uphill · Free — From the promenade, climb the steps or sloped streets to reach Domnească Street.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Currency: Romania uses the Leu (RON), not euros. ATMs are plentiful downtown; withdraw a small amount for street food and market stalls — cards work at restaurants and museums.
- Use Bolt, not street taxis: The Bolt ride-share app is widely used in Galați. It eliminates meter disputes and language barriers — download it before you dock.
