Where the Dardanelles narrowed history — the Gallipoli Peninsula is a vast open-air memorial to the 1915 WWI campaign, sacred to Australians, New Zealanders, and Turks alike. No other port will move you quite like this.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender to Eceabat (peninsula); some ships dock at Çanakkale (Asian side) and ferry across

Best For: WWI history, ANZAC pilgrimage, Dardanelles scenery

Walk to battlefields: Not walkable — hire a tour, taxi, or rental car from Eceabat

Don't Miss: ANZAC Cove, Lone Pine Memorial, Chunuk Bair, 57th Regiment Memorial

- ANZAC Battlefield Circuit** — The essential tour: ANZAC Cove, Lone Pine Cemetery & Memorial, Johnston's Jolly trenches, Chunuk Bair New Zealand...
- Full Peninsula Day — ANZAC to Cape Helles** — Extended tour covering both the ANZAC sector and the British/French landings at Cape Helles (southern tip), including...
- Kabatepe Simulation Center + Battlefield** — Start at the state-of-the-art Gallipoli Historic Area Simulation Center — 11 rooms with 3D projections recreating the...
- Çanakkale Town + Troy Ruins** — If your ship calls at Çanakkale (Asian side), explore the waterfront naval museum and the famous Troy wooden horse from...
- Kilitbahir Castle** — A heart-shaped Ottoman fortress built in 1463 by Mehmed II to control the Dardanelles.

BEST WALKS

- Eceabat Waterfront Stroll** Easy · 20 min · flat — From the tender pier, walk the Eceabat harbor front past small cafes and the ferry terminal.

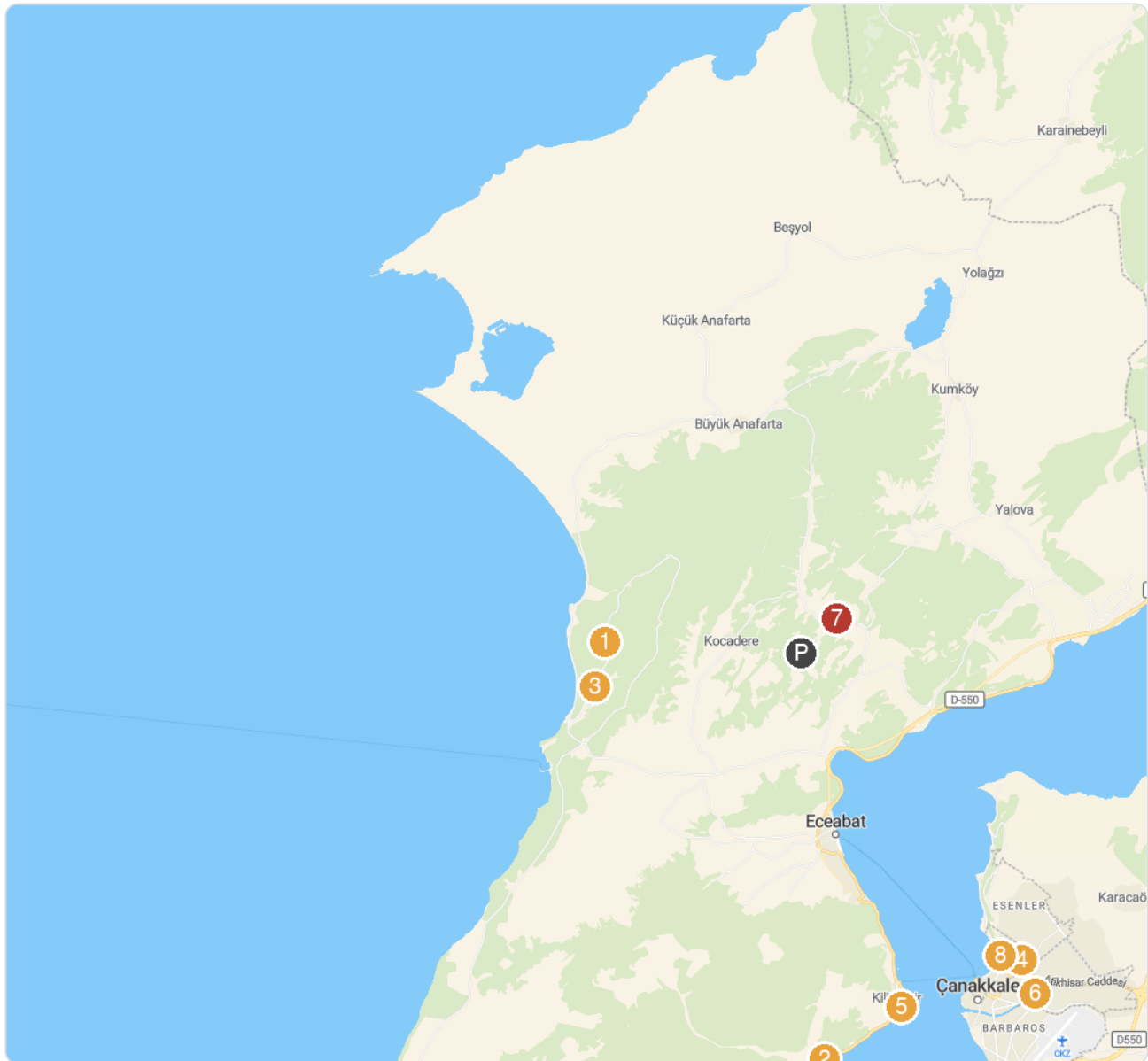
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Book your tour before sailing. Independent access to the battlefields is very difficult. Ship excursions and private operators like TJ's Tours and Crowded House Tours fill up fast...
- Mind the ferry if at Çanakkale. Public ferries to Eceabat run every 30–60 minutes. Build in buffer time — missing the last ferry back
