TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Cliffs of Moher** — Ireland's most famous natural sight — sheer sea cliffs rising over 200m (max 214m) and stretching 14 km along the...
 - **Connemara & Kylemore Abbey** — Wild Atlantic bog, purple mountains, and a fairy-tale Gothic abbey reflected in a lake.
- **Aran Islands Ferry** — Ancient stone forts, dry-stone walls, and a way of life unchanged for centuries.
 - **Galway City & Latin Quarter Walk** — Explore the medieval Spanish Arch, the winding lanes of the Latin Quarter, and St.
 - **Galway Seafood & Pub Culture** — Galway Bay oysters paired with Guinness are a local institution.

BEST WALKS

- **Spanish Arch to Eyre Square Stroll** 1.2 km · 15 min · Flat · All abilities — Walk from the medieval Spanish Arch along the River Corrib quayside, through the colourful Latin Quarter on Quay Street, past the...
- **The Long Walk & Claddagh** 2 km · 25 min · Flat · Scenic — Follow the picturesque Long Walk promenade past the row of pastel-coloured houses facing Galway Bay, then cut through the historic...
- **Salthill Promenade** 3 km · 35 min · Flat · Coastal — Walk or taxi to the seaside suburb of Salthill and stroll 'The Prom' — a 2 km coastal walkway along Galway Bay.

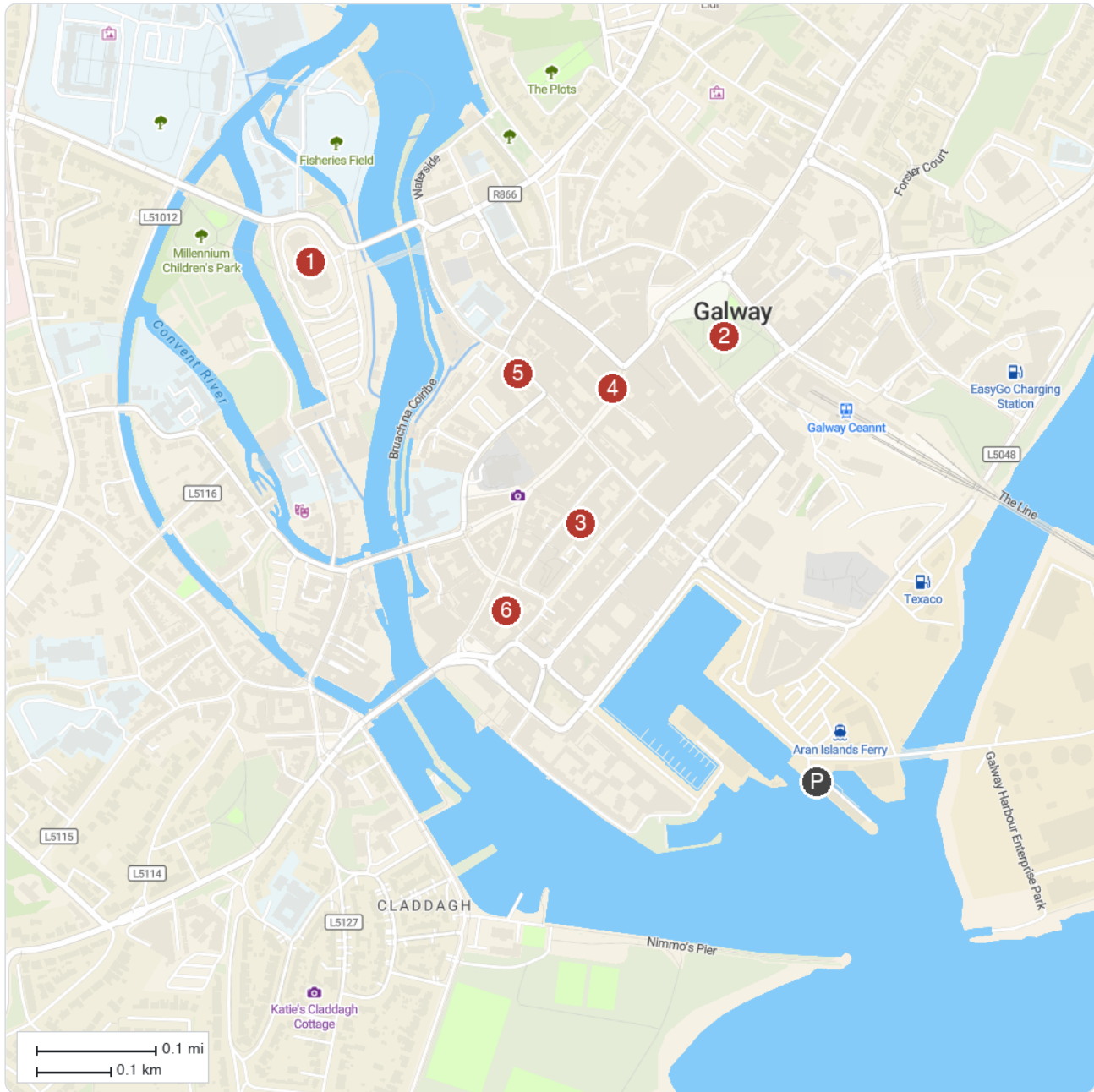
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
