TOP THINGS TO DO

- Great Ocean Road Highlights** — The world-famous coastal drive begins just 30 minutes from Geelong.
- National Wool Museum** — Housed in an 1872 bluestone wool store, this museum tells the story of the industry that built Geelong.
- Surf Coast & Torquay** — Torquay is the birthplace of Rip Curl and Australia's surf capital.
- Geelong Heritage & Bollards Walk** — Over 100 painted wooden bollards line the waterfront, each depicting a historical character — lifesavers, Koori...
- Bellarine Peninsula Wineries** — The Bellarine Peninsula south of Geelong produces outstanding cool-climate Pinot Noir and Chardonnay.

BEST WALKS

- Waterfront Bollards & Eastern Beach Walk** 3 km | 45-60 min | Flat, paved — From Cunningham Pier, head east along the waterfront path spotting the famous painted bollards.
- Waterfront to CBD & Little Malop Street** 1.5 km each way | 20 min | Slight incline to CBD — Head inland from the waterfront up Moorabool Street to Geelong's CBD.

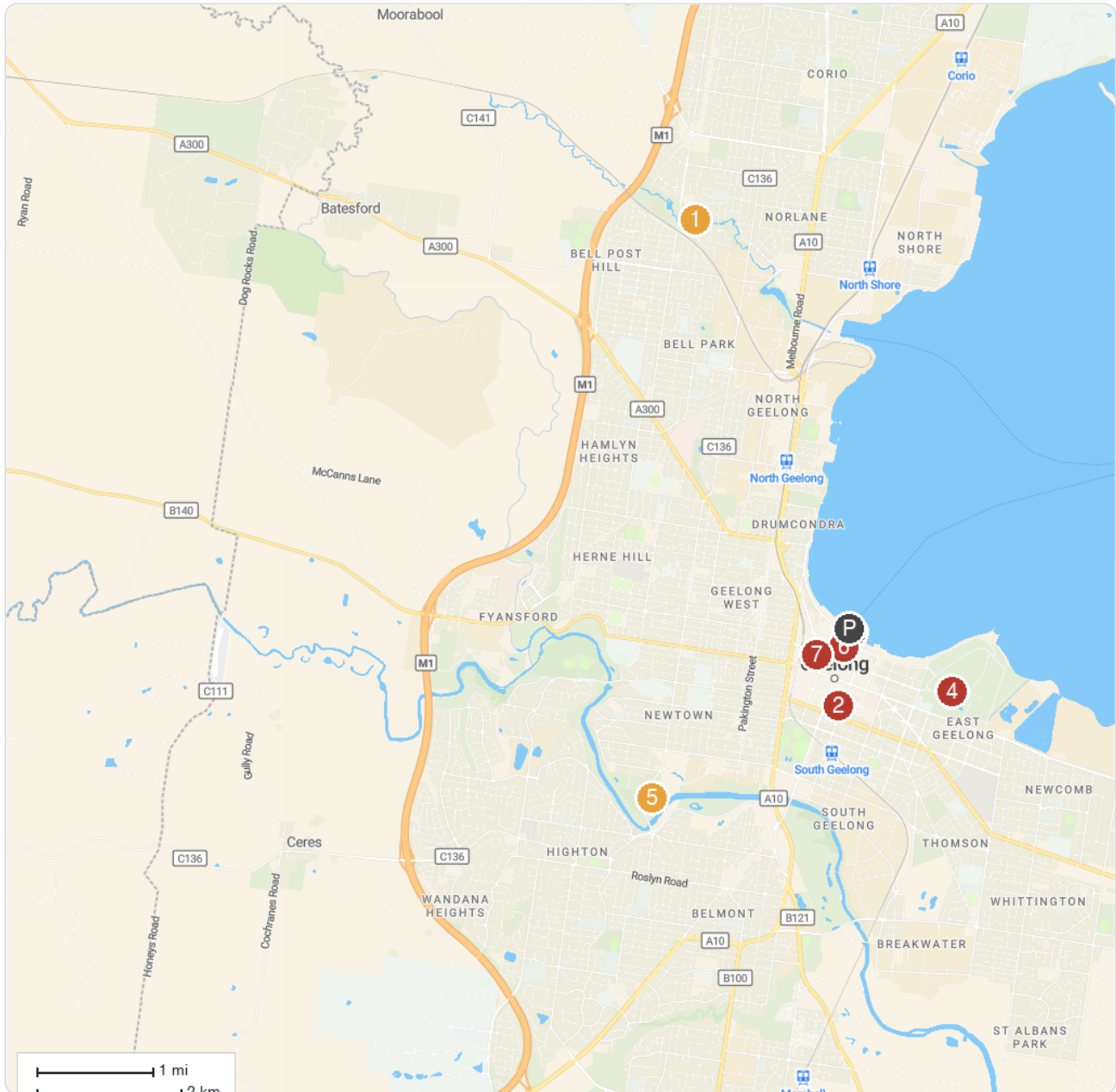
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
