GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender to village pier (2–10 min ride); select ships use SeaWalk floating dock

Best For: Fjord scenery, viewpoints, waterfall hikes, RIB safaris

Walk to centre: You land in the village centre — shops and cafes are steps away

Don't Miss: Seven Sisters waterfall from the water, Flydalsjuvet viewpoint

Getting around: Taxi ~700 NOK/hr (~\$65 USD) · Rideshare not available · Hop-on hop-off City Sightseeing Geiranger

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Dalsnibba Skywalk & Eagle Road** — Bus tour ascending to Dalsnibba at 1,500 m — Europe's highest fjord viewpoint accessible by road — then past the 11...
 - RIB Fjord Safari** — High-speed rigid inflatable boat tour close to the Seven Sisters, The Suitor, and Bridal Veil waterfalls, plus the...
- Kayaking the Geirangerfjord** — Guided kayak tours paddle directly beneath the waterfalls and along the fjord walls.
 - Norwegian Fjord Centre** — Modern museum in the village covering the geology, ecology, and human history of the Norwegian fjords, including the...
 - Skageflå Mountain Farm Hike** — Take a sightseeing boat to Skagehola then hike steeply up to the abandoned Skageflå farm perched above the fjord...

BEST WALKS

- Waterfall Walk (Fossevandring) to Norwegian Fjord Centre** 1.2 km | 327 steps | ~45 min | Free — A paved path and staircase rising from the village centre past Storfossen waterfall to the Norwegian Fjord Centre.
- Village Waterfront Stroll** 0.5 km | Flat | ~15 min | Free — A short walk along the Geiranger waterfront past the tourist office, local shops, and the Geiranger Chocolate Factory.
