Docking: Ships dock at Stazione Marittima, right in the city centre — no tender

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Portofino & Santa Margherita Ligure** — The postcard Italian Riviera village of Portofino is about 35 km east.
- **UNESCO Via Garibaldi & Ducal Palace Walk** — Via Garibaldi (Strada Nuova) is lined with 16th-century palaces — several are open as museums (Palazzo Rosso, Palazzo...
- **Acquario di Genova** — One of Europe's largest aquariums, right at the Porto Antico beside the cruise terminal.
- **Caruggi Food & Pesto Experience** — Wander the tangle of medieval lanes (caruggi) sampling Ligurian street food: focaccia fresh from the oven, farinata...
- **Cinque Terre Day Trip** — The five cliff-hung villages of Cinque Terre are about 90 km southeast — reachable by train (change at La Spezia) or...

BEST WALKS

- **Porto Antico to Via Garibaldi** 2.5 km · ~45 min · Easy-moderate — Start at the Acquario di Genova on the waterfront, walk through the Piazza Caricamento to the medieval Palazzo San Giorgio, then head...
- **Caruggi Loop — Cathedral & Columbus** 2 km · ~40 min · Moderate (cobblestones & inclines) — From the port, duck into the medieval caruggi.
- **Castelletto Viewpoint (Lift)** Short walk + lift · ~30 min — Take the Ascensore Castelletto (a public lift) from Piazza del Portello up to the Spianata Castelletto (Belvedere Montaldo) for...

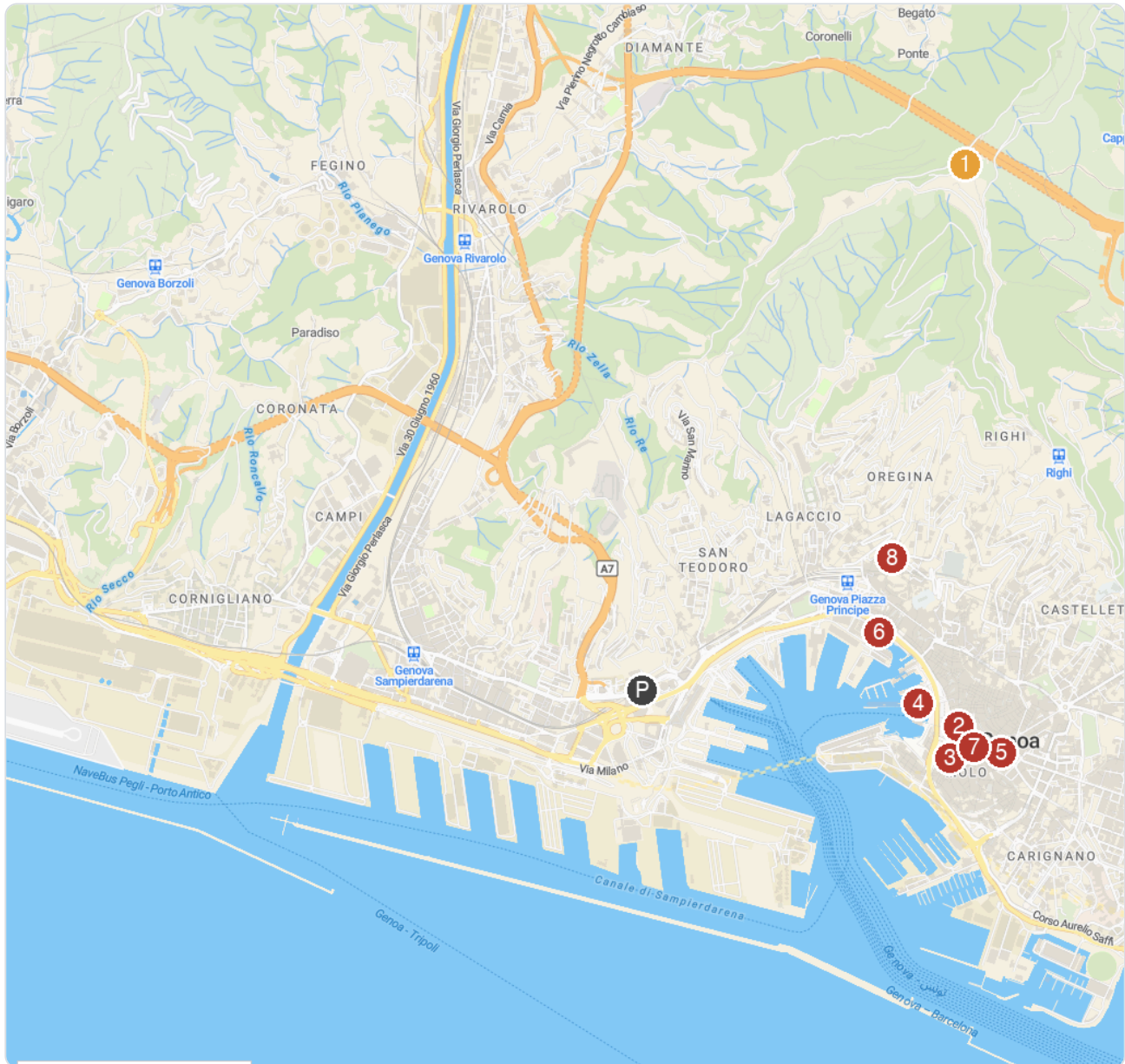
